DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

The department is focused on fulfilling the social and educational mission of the great social reformer, Sree Narayana Guru by giving the best education possible to the UG and PG students. Faculties maintain accessibility to our students and also work in collaboration with each other and other departments through the University of Kerala. Along with developing academic proficiency, the department also aims to increase the general cultural background of all students, chemistry majors for graduate study, prepare post to equip them for to industrial/laboratory/research/teaching positions. The department believes in maintaining high standards and follows the guidance of the university of Kerala and UGC. We continue to work towards being the best all-around chemistry department in the state.

The usual department programmes for the academic year 2017-2018started on June itself. Regular meetings were conducted in the department for planning and achieving departmental activities. Amal CS, of B.Sc. Chemistry secured FIRST RANK in the University of Kerala B.Sc. Chemistry. This was the first-time achievement in the history of college. Post graduate studentsparticipated in seminars. Final year UG and PG students completed their project work in the college itself. Special classes were conducted on holidays for the students who need special attention/improvement. Remedial classes were conducted for students who have failed in the previous examinations. Regular internal examinations, assignments and seminars were conducted for PG and UG students.
