

Guru's philosophical verdicts are exhibited at various sites inside the campus to enlighten the students on the importance and relevance of Guru's philosophy in everyday life.










Guru with Mahatma Gandhi-painting done by students at the entrance of the main building

Activities of the De-Addiction Club


Programme conducted by excise department as part of De-Addiction Club.
