REPORT OF SCHOLAR SUPPORT PROGRAMME 2016-2017

The Scholar Support Programme started in the college during 2014-2015. Students are selected for the program based on their marks obtained in Internal and University Examinations. The program started from October 2016 during the academic year 2016-2017. Everything was done as per the rules and regulations of the programme and with the consent of the college council. The weaker students get additional attention and they get an opportunity to learn the concepts and ideas again which are difficult for them through this programme.

A SSP Cluster Workshop 2017 sponsored by Higher education department, Govt of Kerala was conducted on 21/01/2017 (9.00am-4.00pm) in the college. The workshop hosted for five other colleges namely, S. N College Kollam, S. N College for Women Kollam, St.Stephan's Pathanapuram, St.John's Anchal and S.N. College Chathanur. The first technical session has started at 10.00 by the presentation of Dr. Pramod S.K. on "Art of Counseling". He gave a brief idea about the counseling and how we can handle the students in different situations. The second session was opened at 1.30 pm by Rosama Philip (Associate Professor, Mount Tabor Training College, Pathanapuram). She had presented the basic elements of Mentoring Skills for teachers" in a very fruitful manner. Certificates of participation were awarded to all the participants and the programme was successfully completed.

Two external mentoring programmes were conducted in the college for the students. The first session was handled by Mr. Ajith Kumar Ramaswamy (Director, mentor academy, Kollam) on 4/3/2017, 10am - 4pm. He gave a talk on "Mentoring and counseling skills" for the students. We got a very positive feedback from the students and the session was very fruitful. The second session was handled by Dr. Jayakumar K. (Post doctoral fellow (on leave), University of Oslo) on 30/03/2017, 10am -4.00pm. His talk was on the personal and career development.

Fund of Rs. 2,25,500 were sanctioned to meet the expenses in connection with conduction of the programme. An amount of Rs.2,21,310 was utilized under various heads for the above purpose. An unutilized amount of Rs.4200/- was refunded to the programme. Hence a total of Rs. 2,25,510 was utilized. All the records were properly maintained, accounts were audited and

utilization certificate was produced to the department concerned. The programme was successfully completed in the college during the academic year 2016-2017.
