Seminars and Workshops

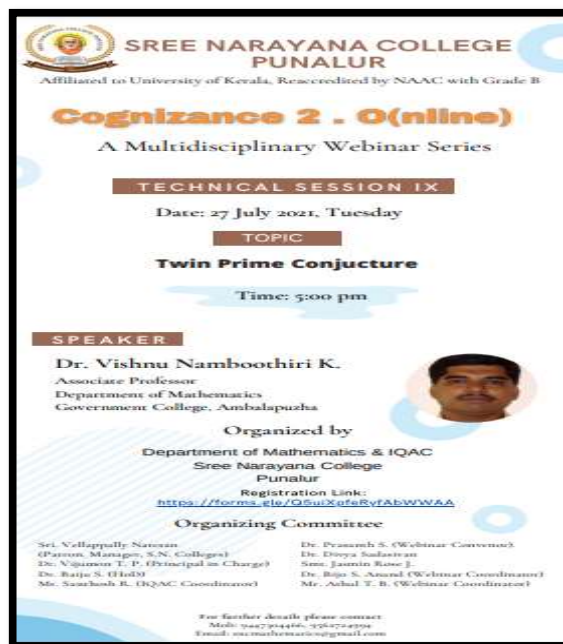

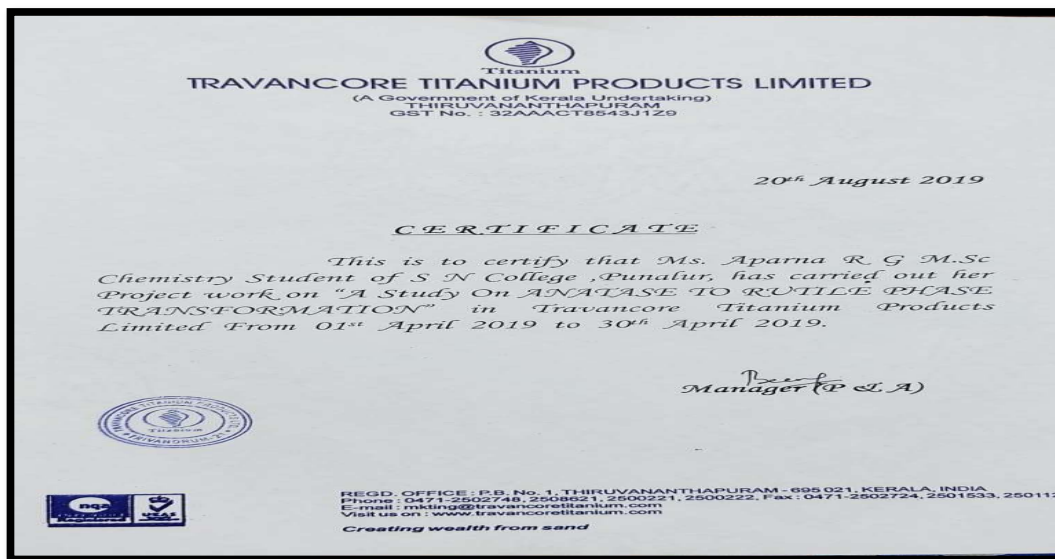

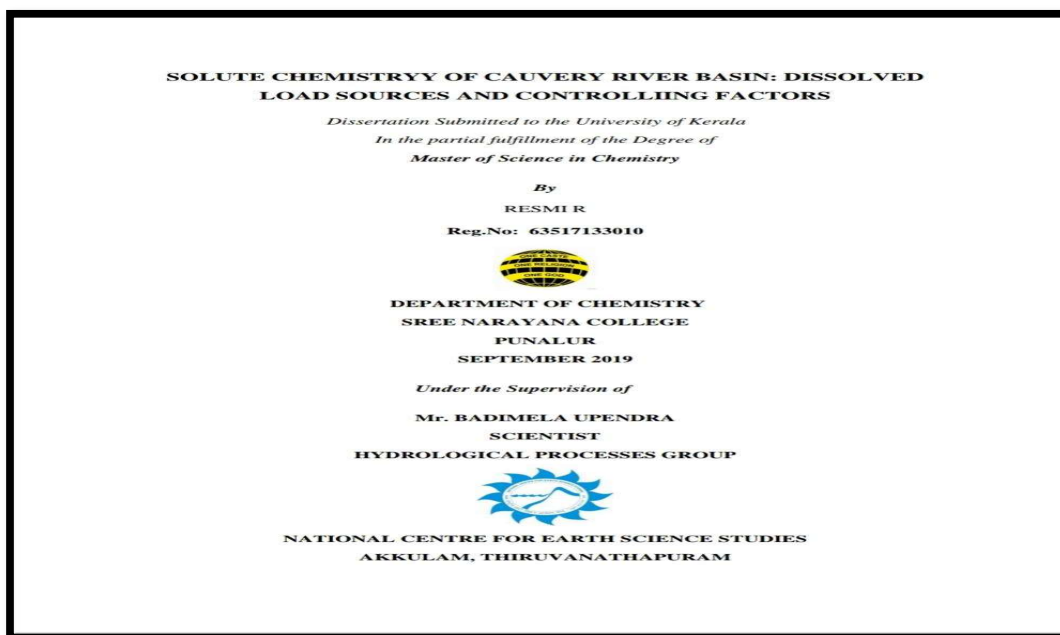

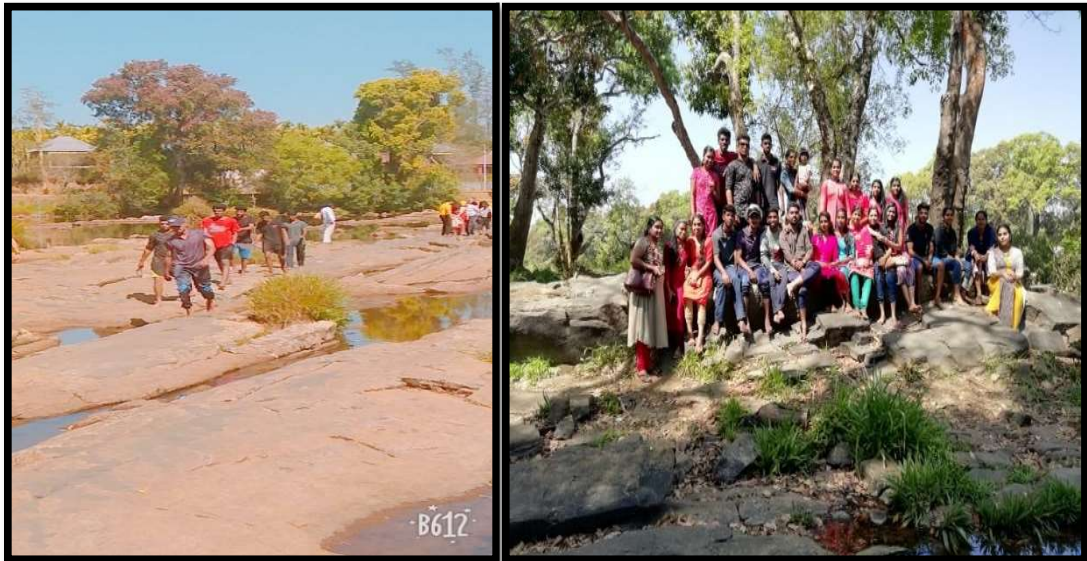
