

- 4. KSCSTE has to be duly acknowledged as 'jointly organized by PIC-Kerala/ KSCSTE' in all the published materials, brochure, banner, other publicity materials, etc., related to the programme. The programme brochure may be sent to KSCSTE well before the programme.
- Change of venue and/or dates shall be reported to KSCSTE promptly.

Rules

Grant from KSCSTE may be used for specific purposes to cover the expenditure on Honorarium to Resource Persons, Accommodation, Local Hospitality & Travel Expense of Resource Persons, Stationery & Publicity Materials, Refreshment, Local Conveyance and other organizing expenses related to the conduct of the Programmes.

KU colleges to have student palliative clubs

Varsity's National Service Scheme unit to implement project

SARATH BABU GEORGE TRICUANANTHAPURAN

The University of Kerala will soon institute Student Palliative clubs in its affiliated colleges as part of enhancing its community outreach activities.

Under the programme, college students will tend to terminally jill patients and those suffering from acute illness and mental agony. Besides popularising palliative care among the student community, the palliative clubs will be entrusted with assisting in the rehabilitation of patients and participating in other palliative care activities within communities.

Students' unions

The university's National Service Scheme (NSS) unit will undertake the project implementation and supervision, while the Department of Students Services has been tasked with ensuring the involvement of students' unions in each colleg-

es. Palliative clubs will comprise 25 students, among which 15 will be selected from among NSS volunteers and the rest from college unions.

Advisory committees consisting of the Principals of the colleges as chairman will also be constituted to advise and monitor the clubs' activities.

The panels will also consist of the NSS programme officer and volunteer secretary, college union chairman, and general secretary as its members.

Training

The palliative volunteers will be imparted training by the Centre for Agroecology and Public, Health Centre that functions under the Department of Economics at the varsity.

Besides, a two-day residential training will be organised on the university premises in October in association with Pallium India, a

pioneer in palliative care in the country.

Around 250 volumeers will be selected from across colleges and imparted training in the initial phase.

Formal launch

While the project had been formally launched by Youth Affairs Minister E.P. Jayara-jan in June, the Syndicate recently gave final shape to the novel initiative and allocated 210 lakh for setting the project into motion and meeting its initial expenditure on the basis of a proposal raised by Pinance standing committee convener K.H. Babujan.

Shaji A., programme coordinator of the university's NSS cell, and the palliative volunteers will associate with palliative care units that function in various places.

Since every NSS unit have their own 'adopted' villages, the service of the volunteer groups under the project will be allotted to the respective areas.

Introduction

Engaging students in palliative care has duel advantages. One is that, their energy can be utilized for the benefit of patients with chronic disease. Another is that, inculcating the spirit of care can have a positive effect principal on the custude of students.

Functional Mechanism

It is proposed that the National Service Scheme will initiate the implementation of the scheme as well as monitor and supervise it, the Department of Students Services will ensure the involvement of the Students Union of the colleges in the implementation of the scheme. Organising awareness campaigns to popularize palliative care among the student community, assist in the rehabilitation of the patients, promote personality of volunteers and students through community services and encourage community participation in the palliative care activities are the major objectives of the scheme. The Coordinator, National Service Scheme and the Director, Students Services will give proper directions to the NSS units and College Unions respectively for starting Palliative Care Units in the colleges which have to function in association with National Service Scheme as well as College Unions. An advisory committee consisting of the Principals of the College as Chairman will be constituted to advise and monitor the activities. This committee may also consist of the NSS Programme Officer, NSS Volunteer Secretary, College Union Chairman and College Union General Secretary as members. Palliative service will be offered from each college by a team of 25 students and among them 15 will be NSS Volunteers and 10 will be from College Unions.

Training Programme

Training programme for Palliative Volunteers will be provided by the Centre for Agro Ecology and Public Health Centre, functioning in the Department of Economics, University of Kerala. Two day residential training-will be conducted on 10 -11 October 2019 at the Senate Chamber, University of Kerala, Palayam and the resource persons for the training will be provided by the Pallium India, a national registered charitable trust formed in 2003 aimed at providing quality palliative care and effective pain relief for patients in India.

Participation of NSS Volunteers in the Training

Each College having NSS units can send one volunteer either male or female for the training. Training kit and food will be provided to the volunteers. Accommodation will be provided at International Youth Hostel PMG Junction to the volunteers from the colleges situated at Kollam, Alappuzha and Pathanamthitta districts. But volunteers from Thiruvananthapuram districts cannot provide accommodation. Travel expense may be met from NSS accounts for

regular activities 2019-20.
