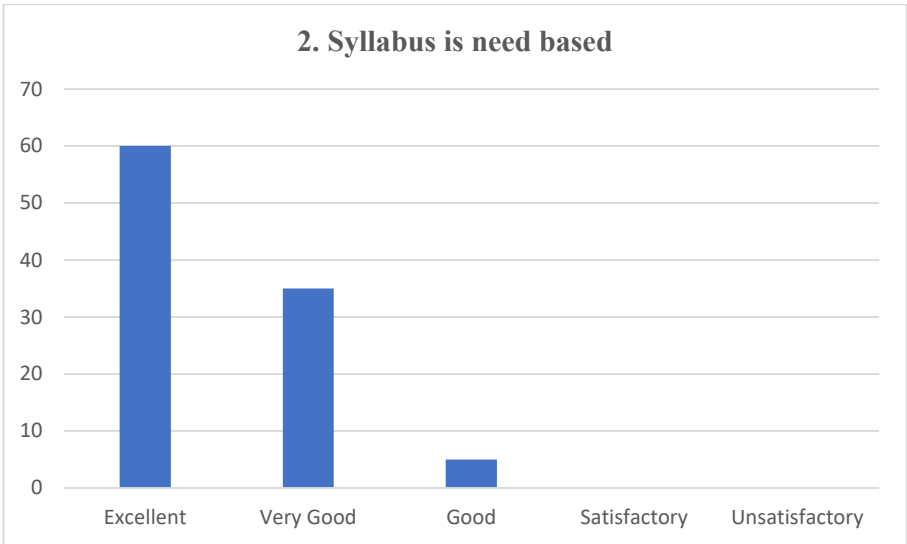
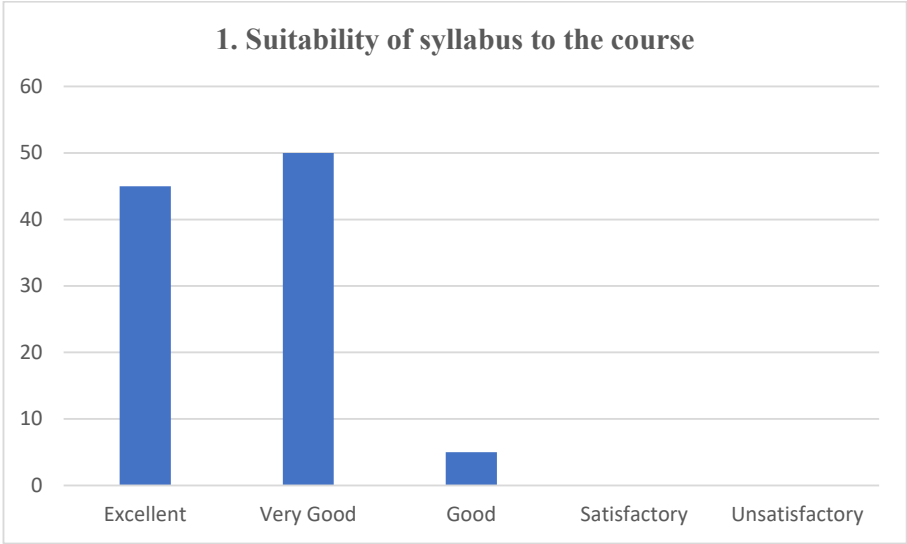


FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT 2020-2021

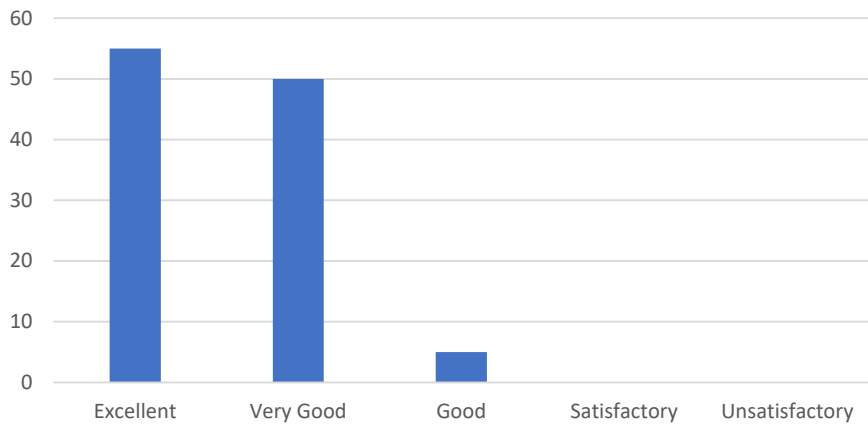

The college has an effective system for collecting feedback from students, teachers, parents and alumni on teaching learning process, syllabus and other facilities of the college. In the academic year 2020-2021, feedback was collected using a five point scale and the responses were analysed by the Internal Quality assurance Cell.

Students Feedback on Course 2020-2021

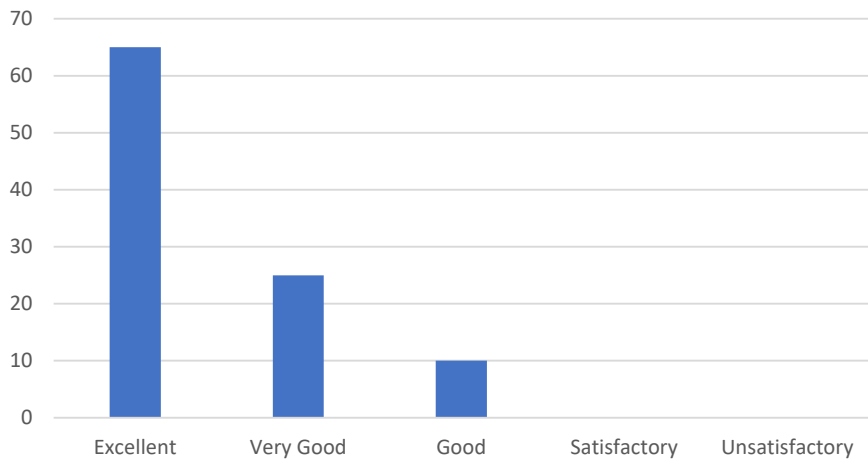
A majority of students are deeply indulged in their favourite subjects. 46% of them stated that the suitability of the syllabus to the course is excellent and 50% of them stated it as very good. The survey results point out that the syllabus is need-based. 45% of students opined that the syllabus have well-defined and clear aims and objectives. 65% of students stated that the availability of reference material for course content is excellent. 85% of students opined that the availability of prescribed books and reference materials in the library is excellent. 70% of students agreed that the syllabus generates interest in the subject area. 82% of students observed that the curriculum has prospects for higher education/ employability. 40% of students opined that the size of the syllabus in terms of the load on the students is huge.



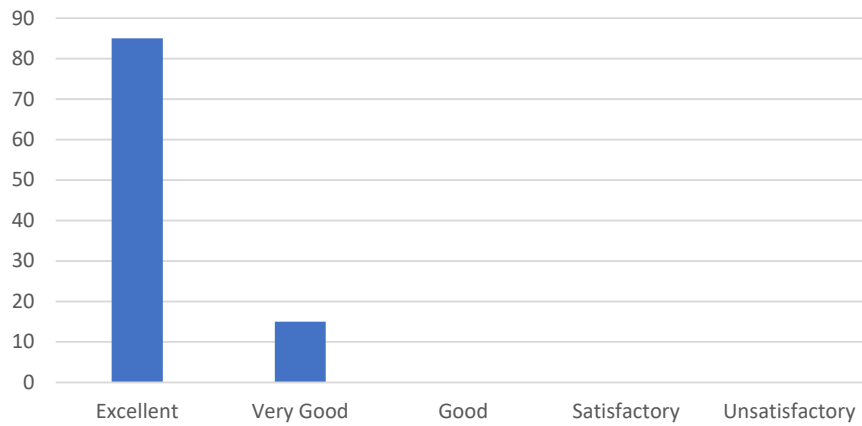

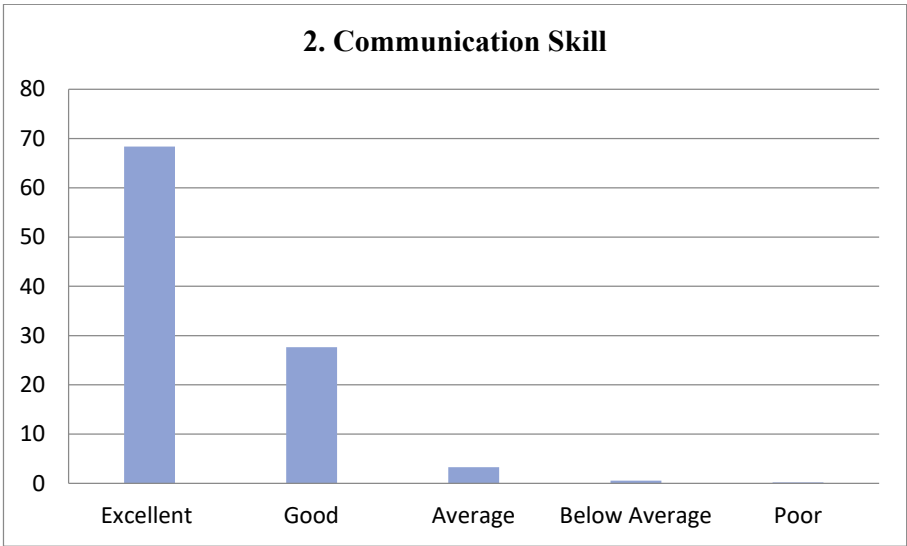
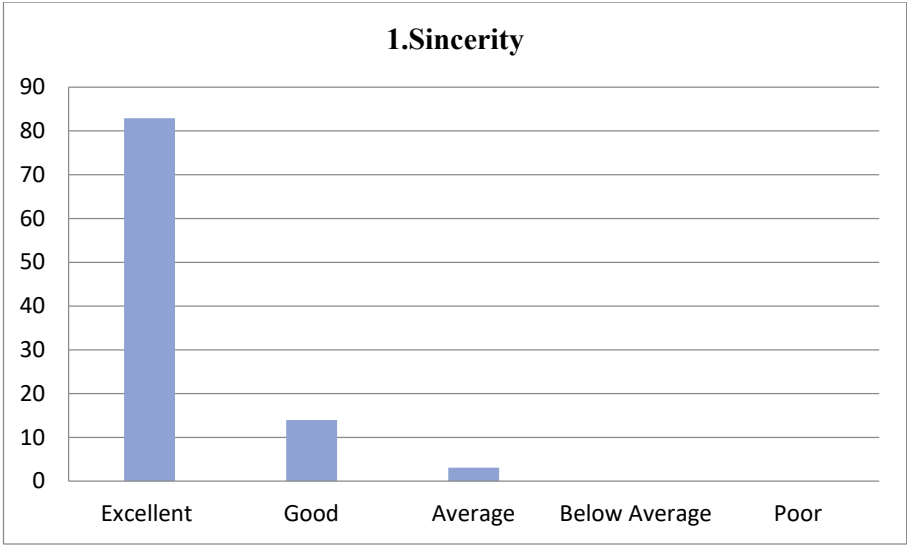
10. Rate the size of syllabus in terms of the load on the student



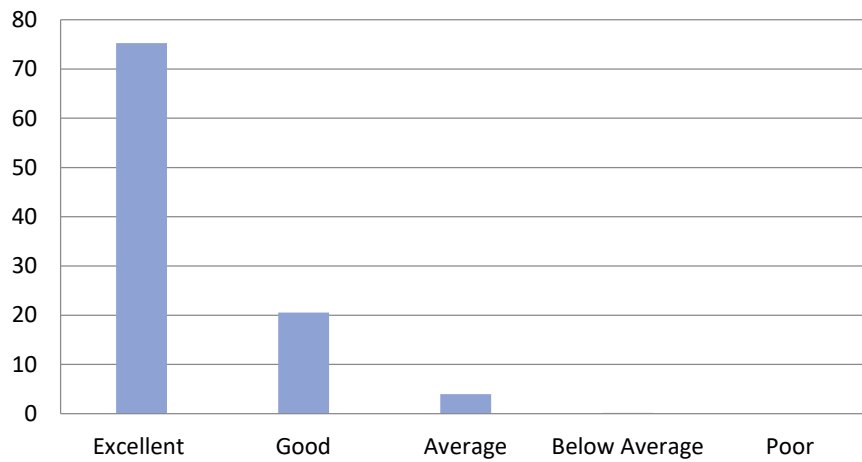


Student Feedback on Faculty

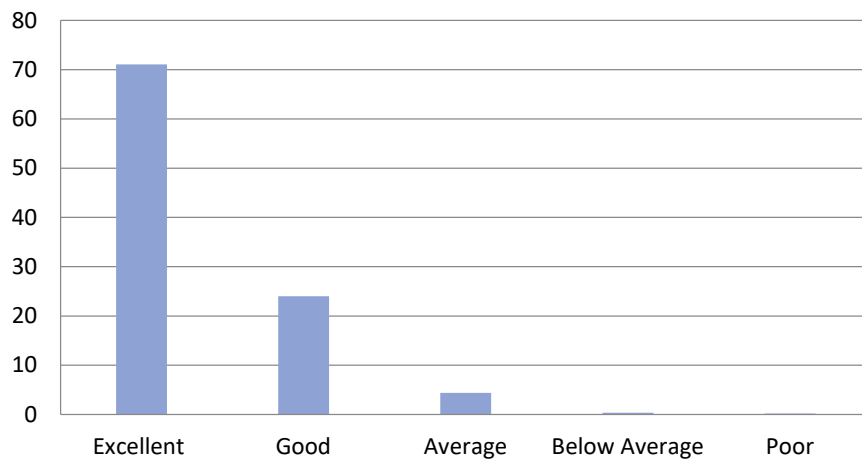
Feedback is collected from students for evaluating teaching standards. Students who have above eighty percentage of attendance were chosen for assessment. Students' opinion on various parameters is measured in a five-point scale ranging from Excellent, Good, Average, Below Average and Poor. 83% of the students stated that the sincerity of the teachers are excellent. 57% of students agreed that the teachers encourages students' participation in class.



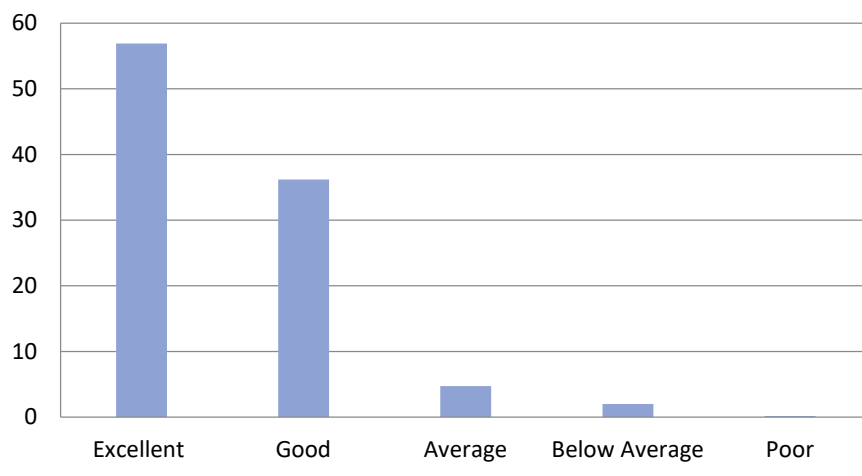

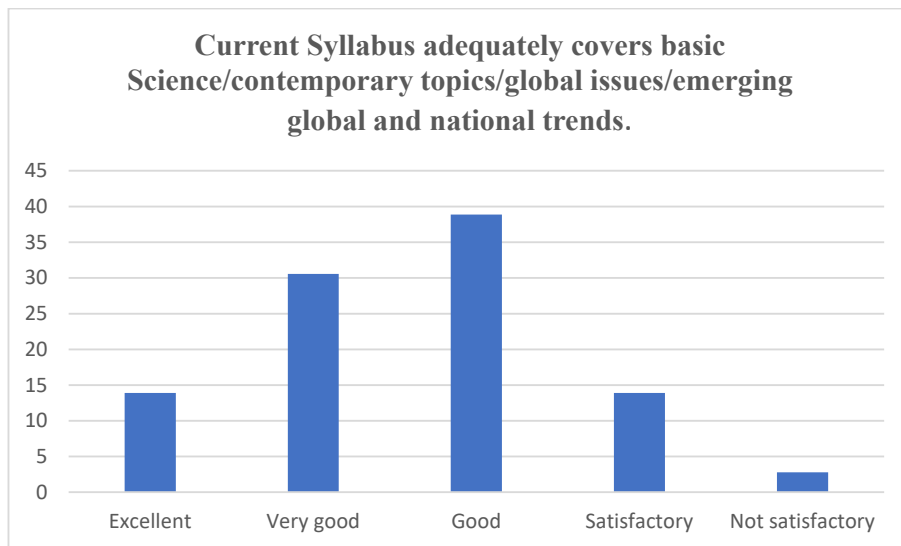
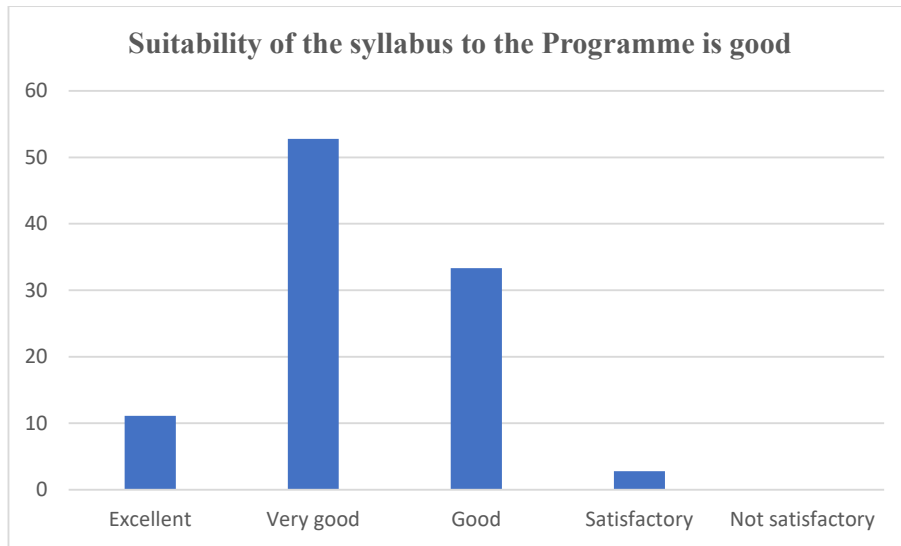




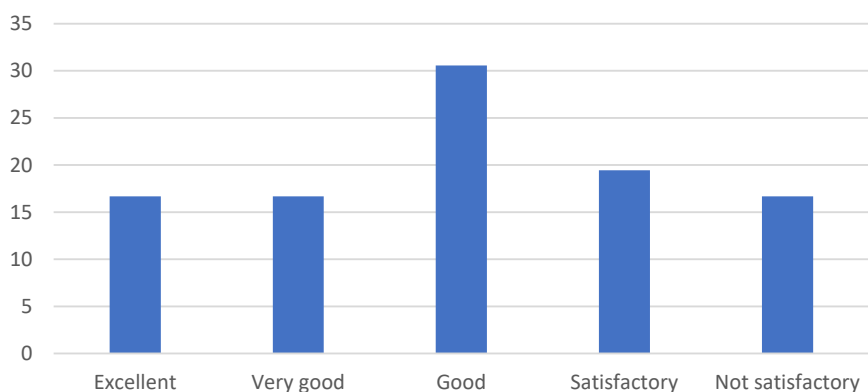
Teacher's feedback on Course and Curriculum 2020-2021

The feedback on syllabus is collected from a total number of 36 teachers. The rating scale includes Excellent, Very Good, Satisfactory and Non-Satisfactory. Teachers' opinion on the syllabus in the academic year 2020-2021 is being analysed and the following results are noticed. 11% of the teachers revealed that the suitability of the syllabus to the programme as excellent. 52% of the teachers opined it as very good. 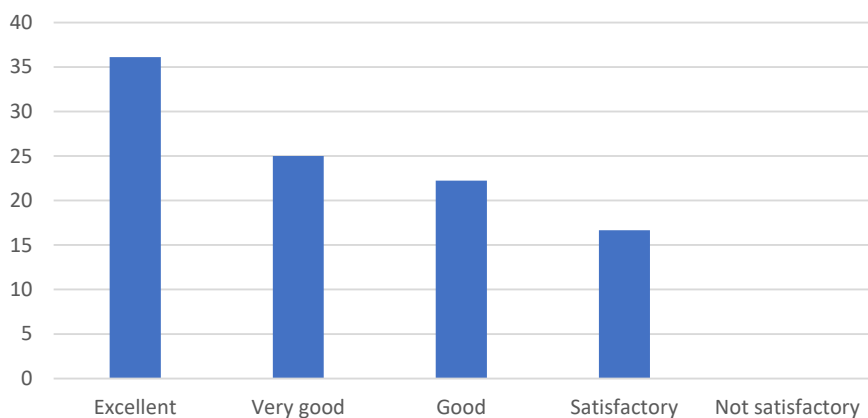
issues/ emerging global and national trends. Feedback Survey points out that the specified contact hours stated in the syllabus are not sufficient to complete the coverage of the syllabus.



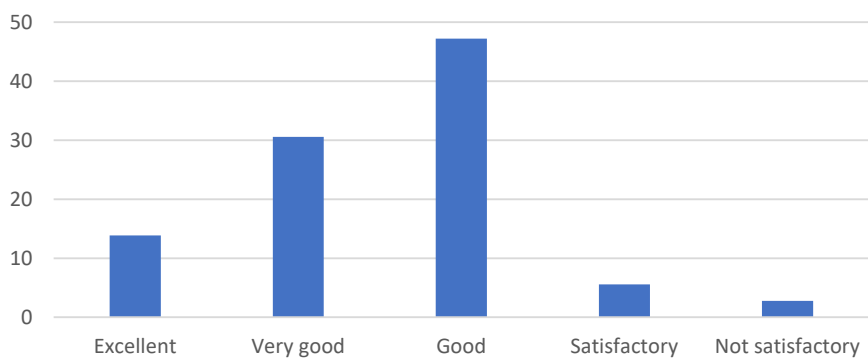
The specified contact hours stated in syllabus is sufficient to complete the coverage of syllabus as per each course by the teachers

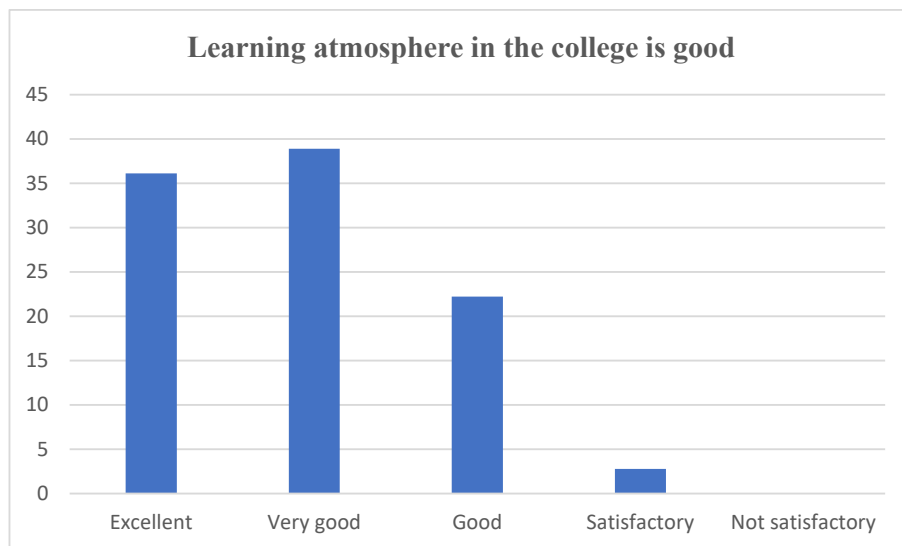
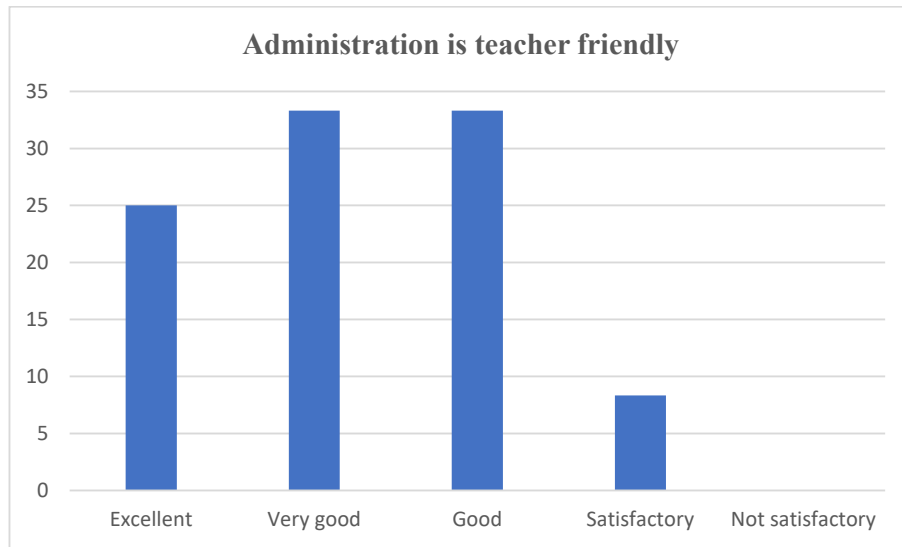


Sufficient reference material and books are available for the topics mentioned in the syllabus.



The current syllabus meets the expectations in terms of learning values, skills, knowledge, attitude, analytical abilities, applicability, relevance and practical orientation to real life situations

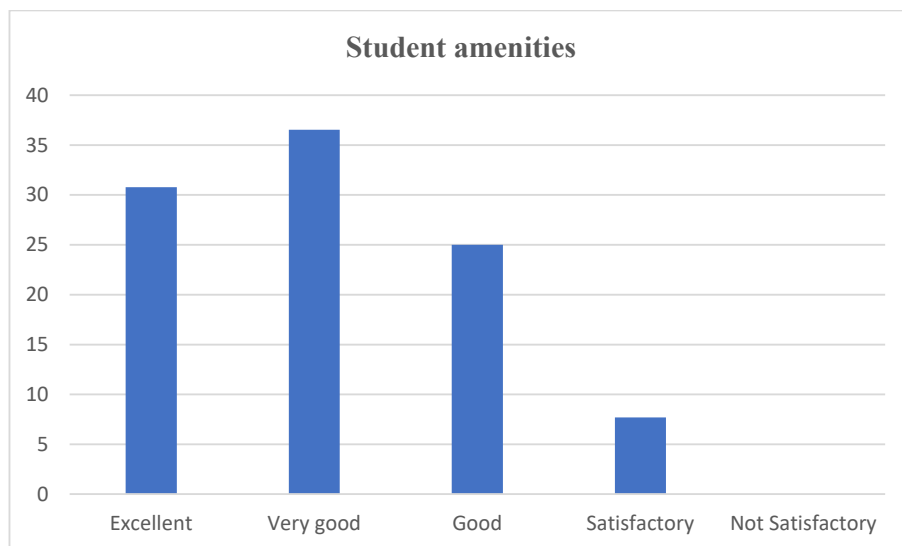
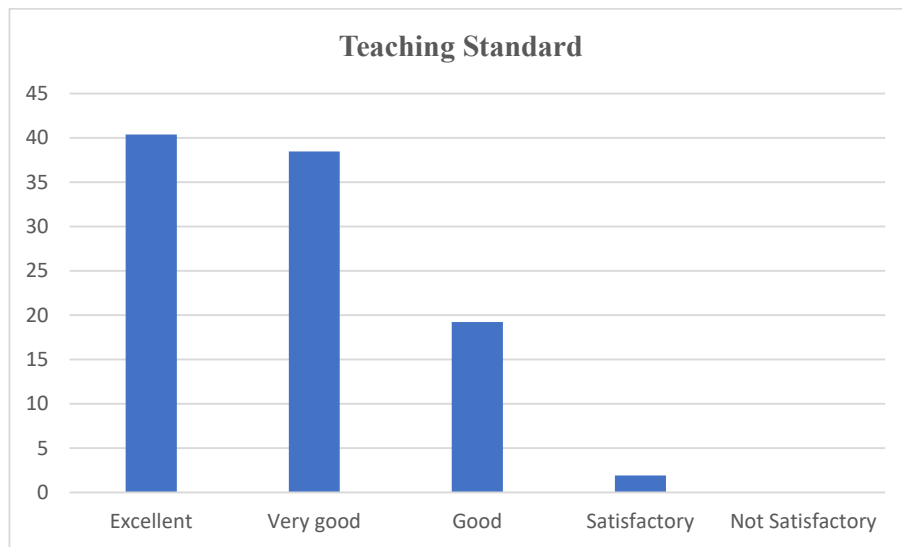


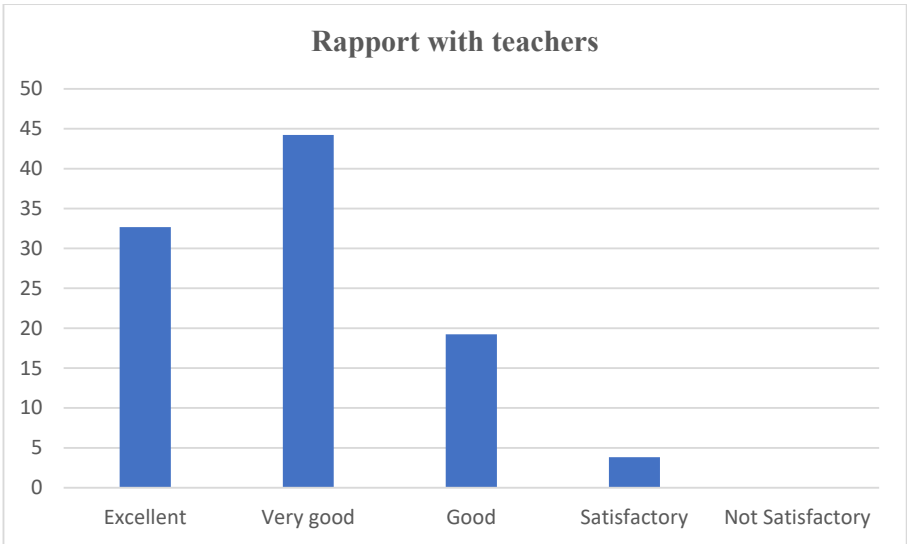
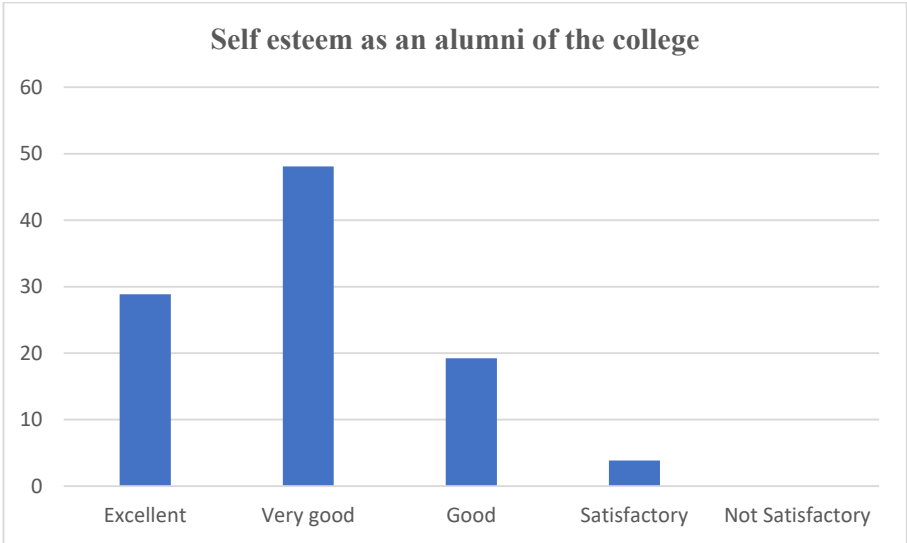
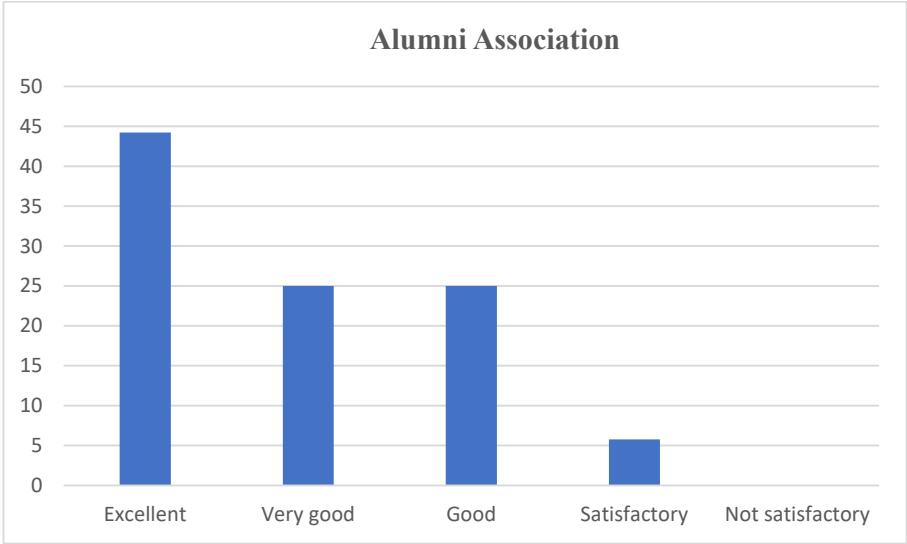


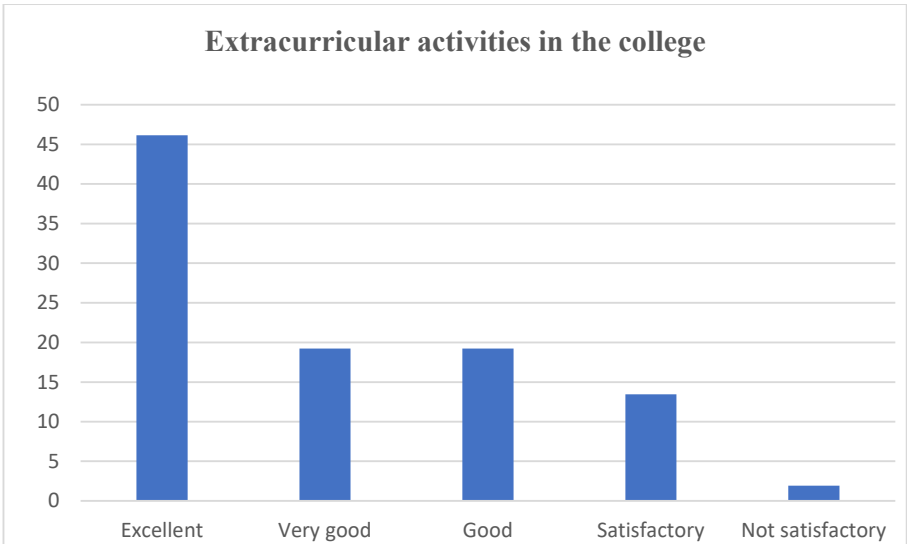
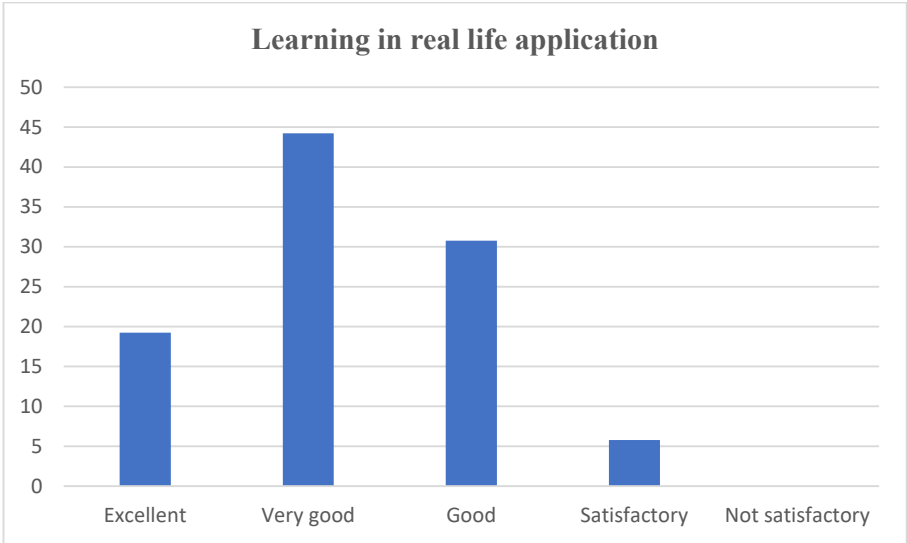
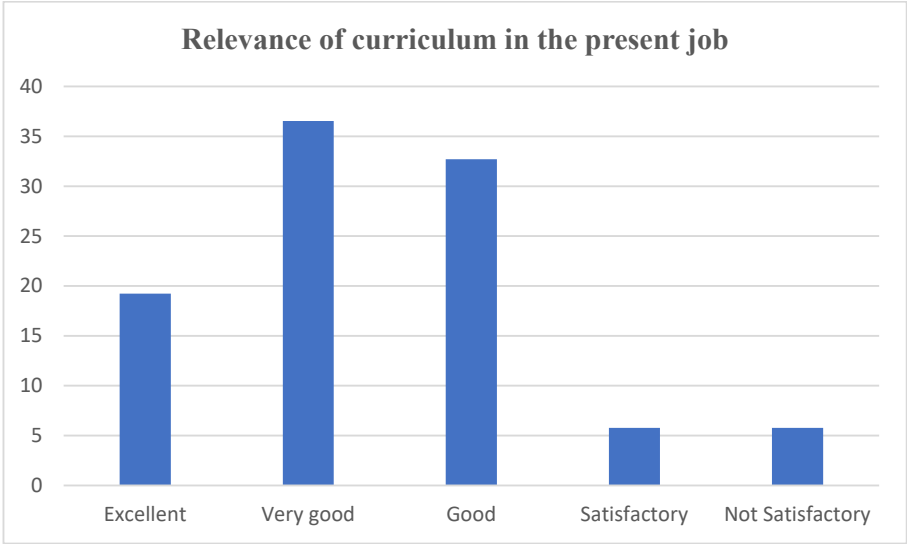
Feedback from Alumni 2020-2021

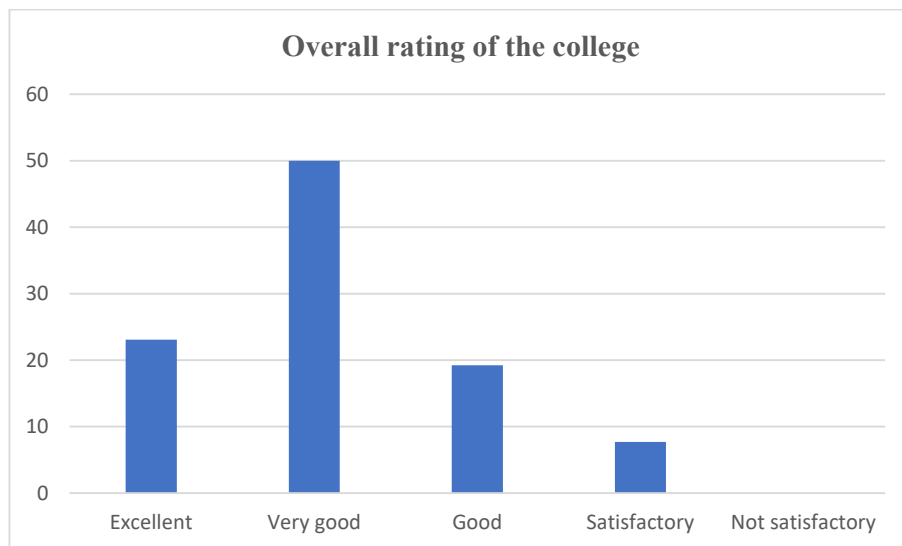
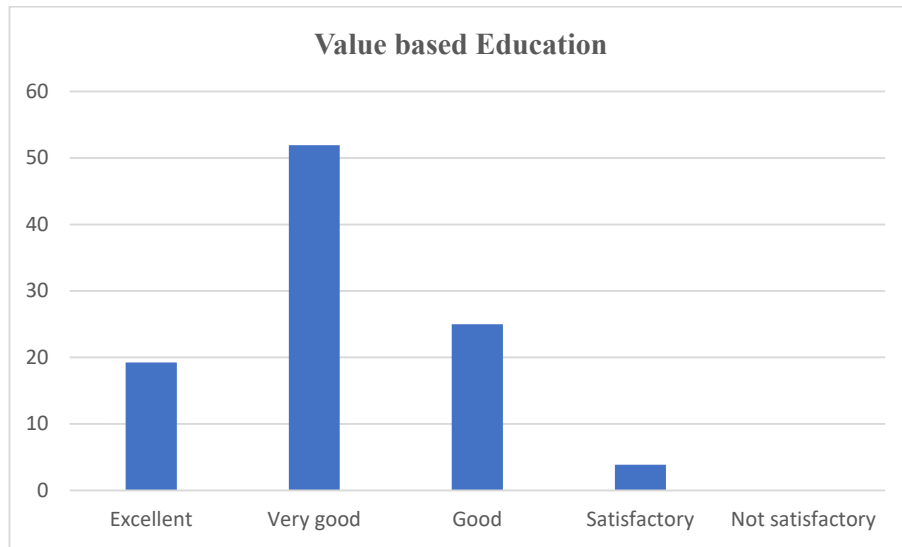
Feedback from alumni is collected with the help of Google forms. Rating parameters include Excellent, Very Good, Good, Satisfactory and Non satisfactory. According to the survey, 40% of alumni stated teaching standards as excellent and 38% of alumni stated it as

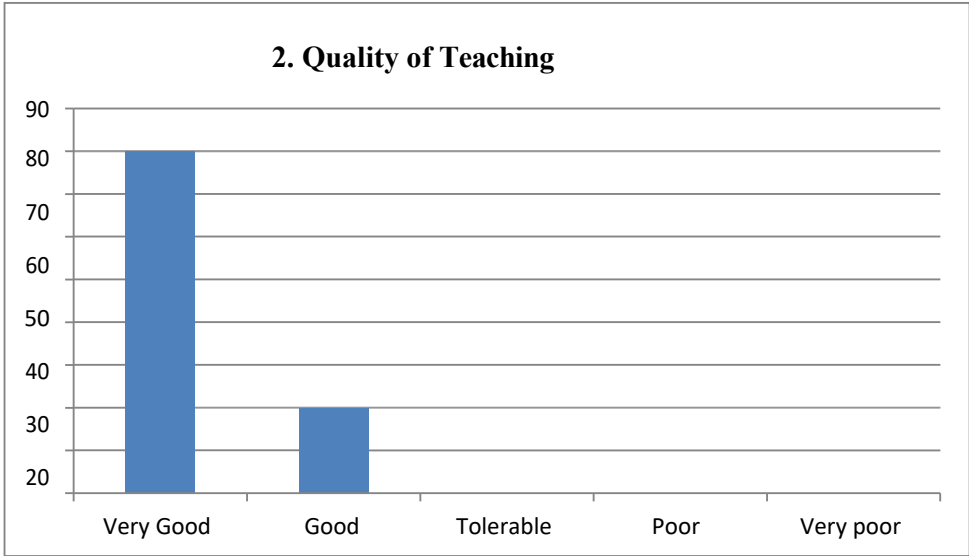
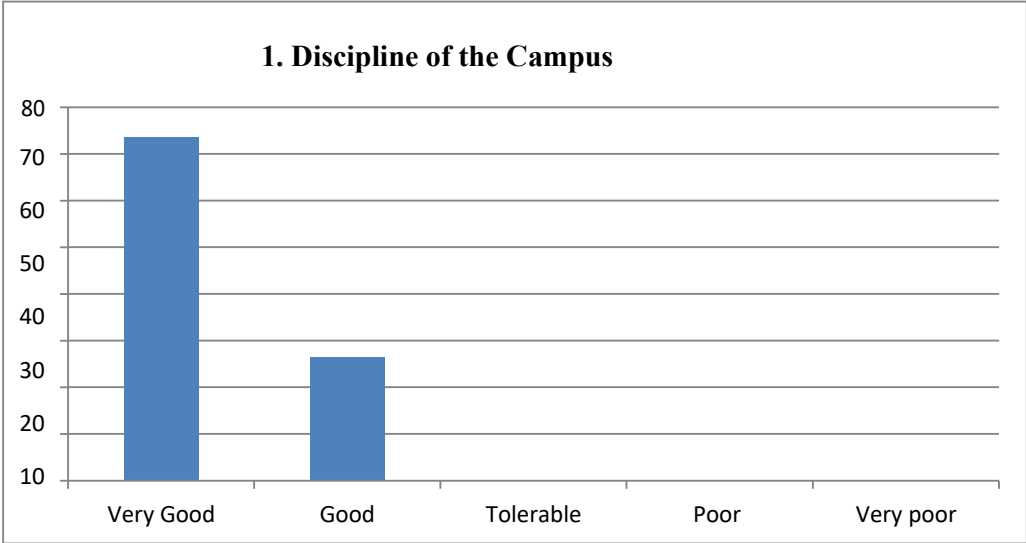


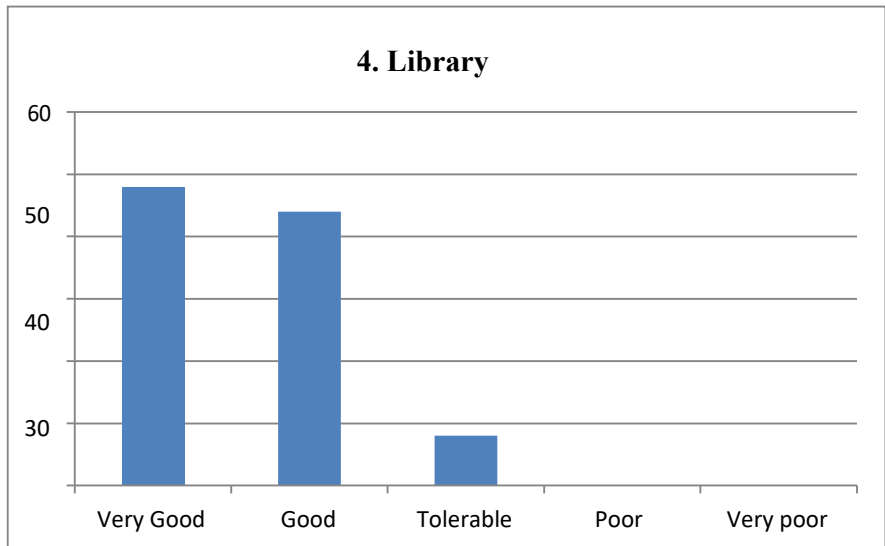
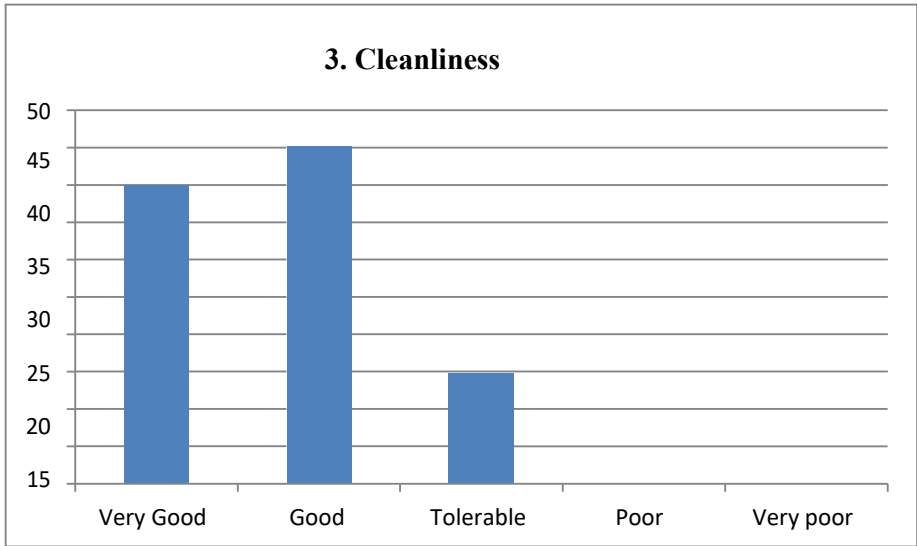


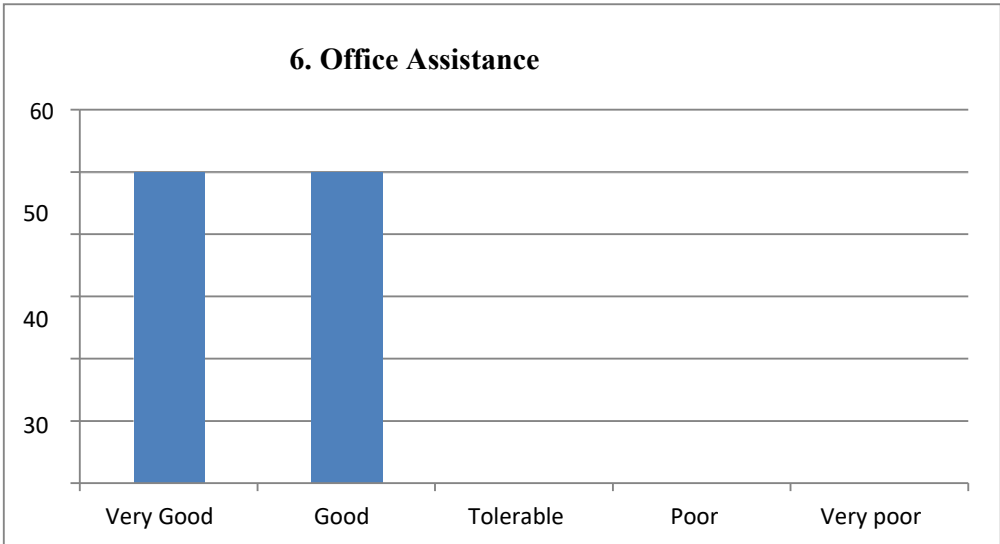
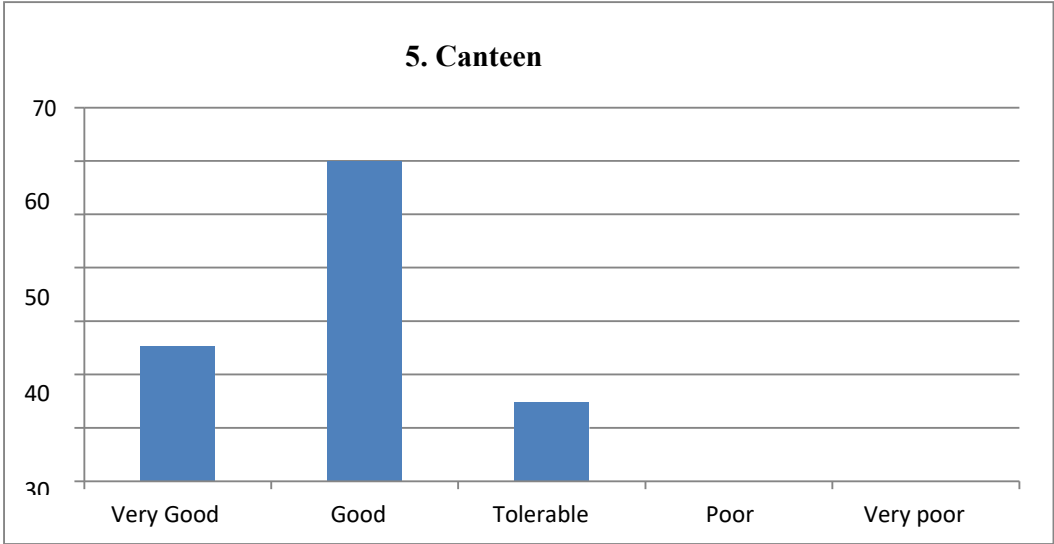


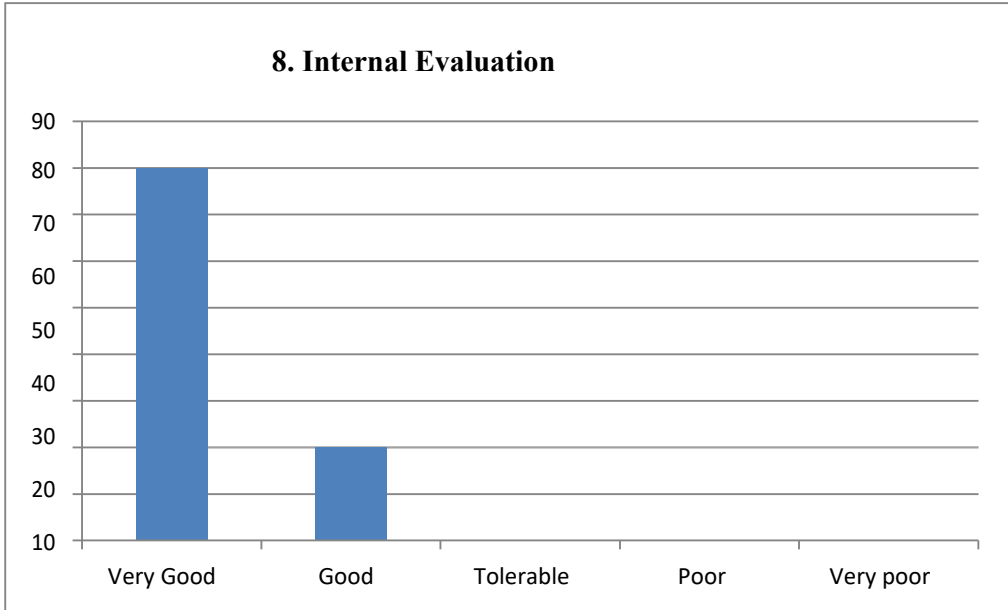
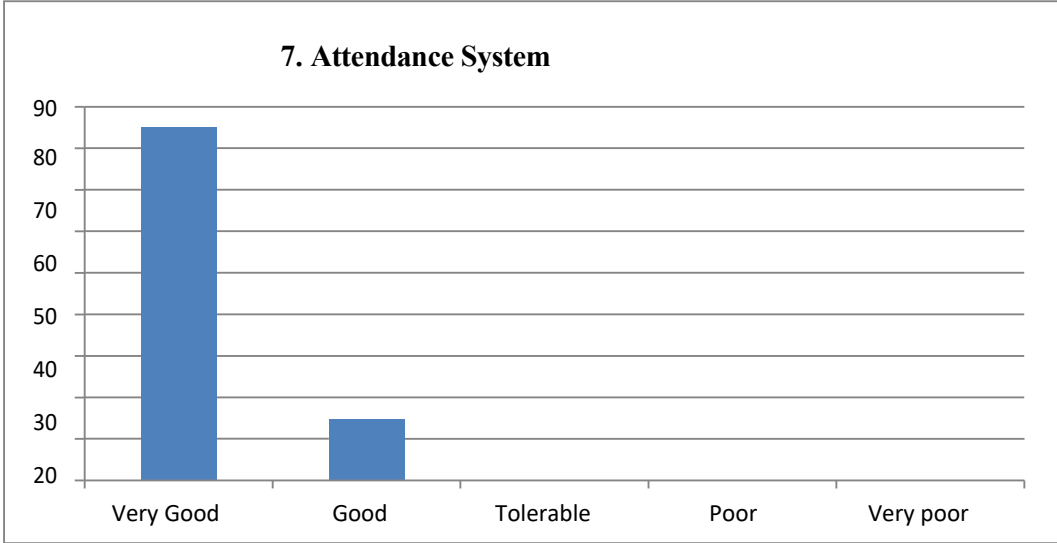
Parent Feedback on facilities of the college 2020-21

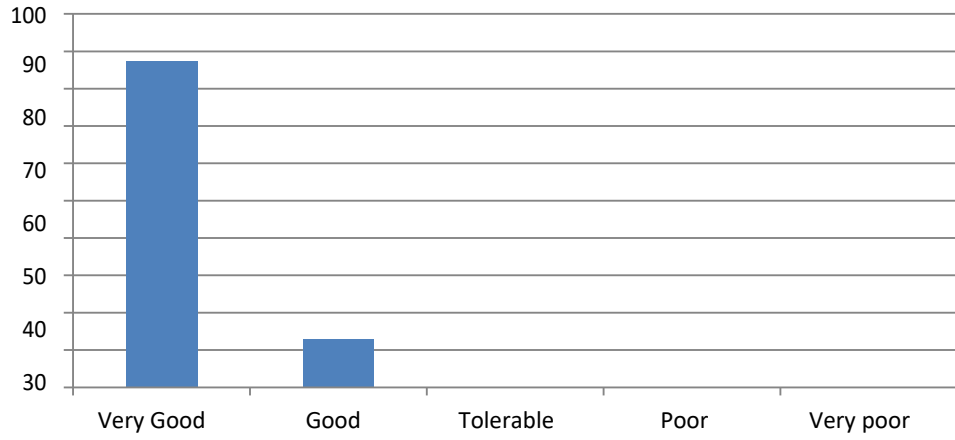




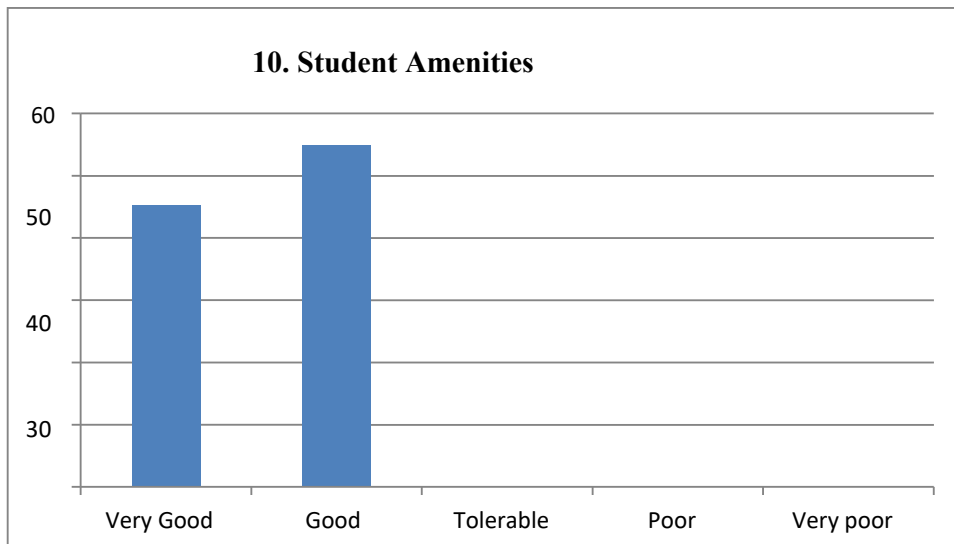
