8. Department of Commerce

The academic year 2019-20 commenced on Monday 3rd June 2019. The Department is offering UG course in Commerce- B. Com with elective Co-operation. The course was started in 1992 and has high demand ratio from the initial years. Nearly 2000 students haveentrolled and completed their graduation from the department. The Department has been facilitating various efforts to develop efficient Commerce graduates and bring them forth for accomplishing their

goals such as acquiring quality business education, training to equip with trending strategies of different sectors of industry, service and business. A good portion of students trained in the department has acquired good positions in and abroad the country. We maintain a good pass ratio in almost all years.

Major activities and achievements of the department are given below

ACADEMIC-

Semester V and Semester III were the two classes functioned in June 2019. We had internal examinations for the second semester B. Com during the month of June 2019. First year classes were started in 6th July 2019 with 30 students and the admission process were completed in July itself. 73 students were enrolled in first year class. There were 69 and 75 students in final and second year respectively. Portions for V and III semester were completed in September 2019 and had internal examinations in the same month. University examinations were in the month of November 2019, soon we started VI and IV semester classes. Due to strike and student agitations the college remained closed 7 days during the semester period. First semester B. Com examinations were held in the month of December 2019. Internal examinations were held in the month of November itself. Corrected answer books were returned to students with 10 days of examination held. Semester II commenced in January first week of 2020. Results of II, III and IV semesters (2017 admission) were publish before February 2020, more than 70% of students passed with good score. For 2018 admission semester I and II results were published in 2020. 45 students out of 67 students passed in B. Com batch., 2016-19, a result of 67.16 percentage. For the III and fourth semesters of 2017 admission, the result was 84 and 92 percentage respectively. Students appeared were 69 and passed were 58 and 64 respectively. We have secured 85 and 71 percentage result for I and II semester B. Com-2018-21 batch. Students passed were 64 and 53 out of 75 appeared.

The major problem we faced was the low number of working days for the VI semester to complete classes and project. The college closed on 14 March, 2020 due to the spread of COVID-10.

SEMINAR/ WORKSHOP CONDUCTED BY DEPARTMENT

Our department conducted workshop on the topic "GOODS AND SERVICE TAX (GST)- A BIRD EYE VIEW ON 2ND SEPTEMBER 2019 in seminar hall. The programme started at 9 am. Smt.Kavitha (assistant professor, department of commerce) welcomed all. Dr.T.PVijumon (Head of Commerce, sn college Punalur) delivered presidential address. Dr.T.PRADEEP (Principal, SN College) was inaugurated this function. Dr.Gopan Raj delivered felicitation address. After formal session our resource person CMA.
