Introduction

Sree Narayana College, Punalur started functioning on 15 July 1965 under the management of Sree Narayana Trusts, Kollam. The college was inaugurated by Sri R Sanker, the then Chief Minister of Kerala, who was the founder Secretary of S N Trusts. The college celebrated its 50 years of pursuit of glory and excellence in 2016 and the valedictory functions were inaugurated by the honourable Governor of Kerala Sri Arif Muhammed Khan on January 14, 2020 in the presence of Sri K Raju, Minister for Forests and Sri Vellappally Natesan, the Manager, Sree Narayana Colleges. The college is affiliated to the University of Kerala and has 12(b) and 2(f) certificates of UGC. Presently the college offers 8 UG and 4 PG courses. The college is re-accredited by NAAC on August 2014 and has secured B Grade with CGPA- 2.51. Accreditation work of third cycle has been started and is progressing. The 1358 students are undergoing their studies in the college in the reporting year.

Teaching and Learning

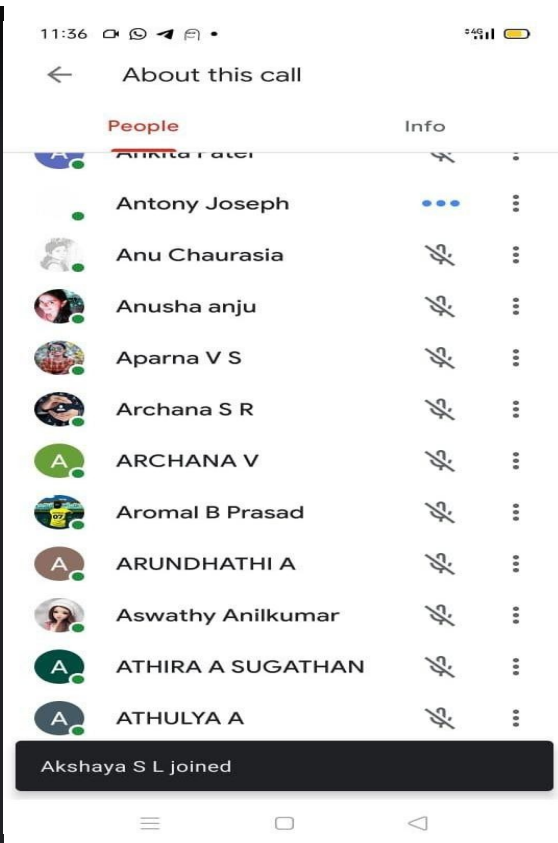
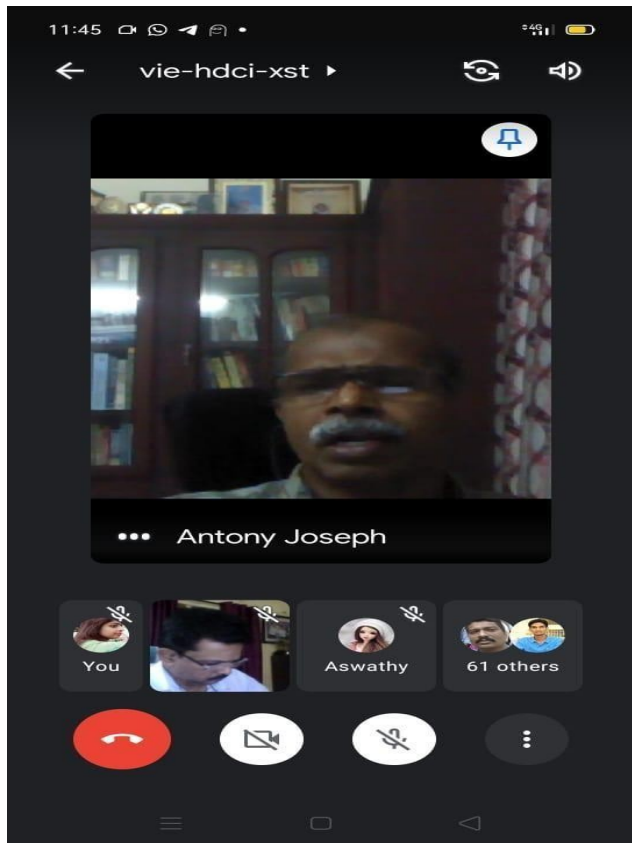

During the time we have conducted internal examinations for all the three semesters and corrected answer sheets were given back to the students. We were forced to conduct the sixth semester internal examinations (2018-21 batch) in online mode due to the fierce second wave of Covid-19. 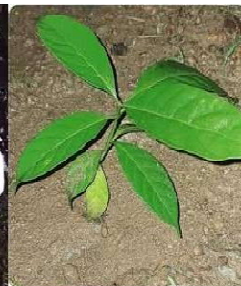

Dr Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam was born on 15 October 1931, at Rameswaram in Tamil Nadu, India. He specialized in Aeronautical Engineering from Madras Institute of Technology and became an eminent scientist. Dr Kalam was awarded the Padma Bhushan (1981), the Padma Vibhushan (1990), and India's highest civilian award- the Bharat Ratna in 1997. In 2002, Dr Kalam became the 11th President of India. He was fondly called the people's President for being the first President in the country to connect with the youth via the internet.

Named as the 'Missile Man' of India for his contributions in the field, he redefined the Presidency during his tenure from 2002 to 2007. He often spoke to children and the country's youth-- inspiring them to think big in life; he also penned a number of books. Dr Kalam succumbed to a massive cardiac arrest and breath his last on July 27, 2015 while delivering a speech at IIM Shillong.

Dr Kalam's three step guide to achieve goals in life are: Finding an aim in life before you are twenty years old; Acquire knowledge continuously to reach this goal; Work hard and persevere so you can defeat all the problems.

Dr.APJ Abdul Kalam was indeed one of the most humble, intelligent, wise, selfless, loving, and lovable leaders ever born. He was born on 15 October 1931 in Rameswaram, Tamilnadu. He was the 11th president of India and served the country for one term. Not only this, but also, he is one of the most famous scientists who have worked with highly famous organizations like DRDO (Defence Research and Development Organization) and ISRO (Indian Space Research Organization) in career.

He was a true gem and a person with no haters. His full name was Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam. He was born in a middle-class Muslim family. Since the beginning of his days, he was a very hardworking and diligent person. In this early childhood, he helped his family to earn livelihood along with the studies. Being very intelligent and promising, he started his career and life soon.

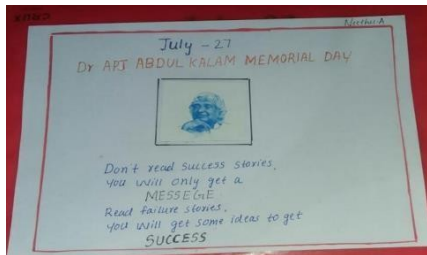
He saw a lot of hardships on his way to success. There was a time when his sister sold her jewellery to pay his college fees. After completing his graduation, he joined the defence department to serve the nation. From there the journey of the famous scientist started to a never-ending tale of success. He was one of the various scientists in India who worked for the development of nuclear power. For his work, he also earned various awards and prizes.

Dr. Kalam was one of the most important figures in the testing of the Pokhran-II in the year 1988. Politics never attracted Dr. Kalam. But in the year 2002, Indian National Democratic Alliance requested him to nominate him for the post of the president. Thinking of the nation and keen eagerness to work for the country, made him say yes. With the support of the Indian National Democratic Alliance, he won the elections and was selected as the president of India.

He was a man of dreams and ideas. He proved that with determination and hard work anything can be achieved. He is one of the many leaders in India who has plenty of admirers.

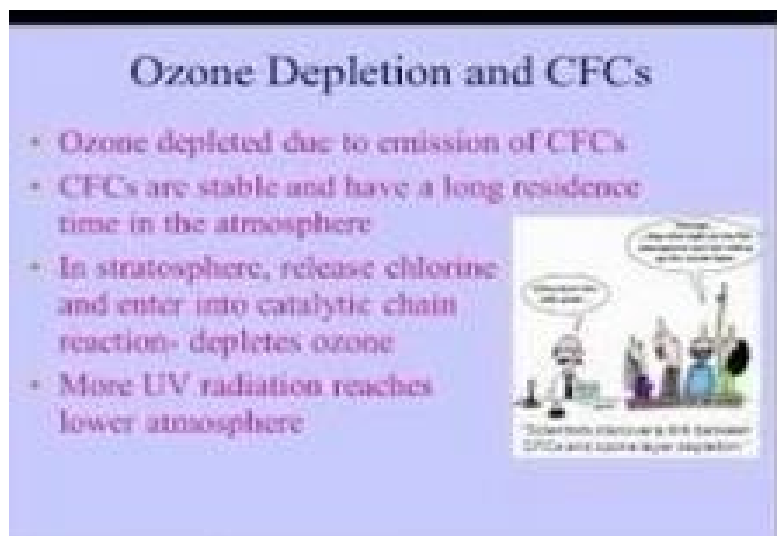

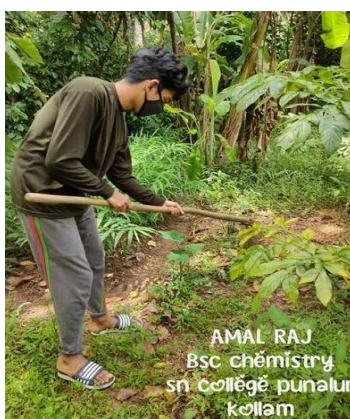
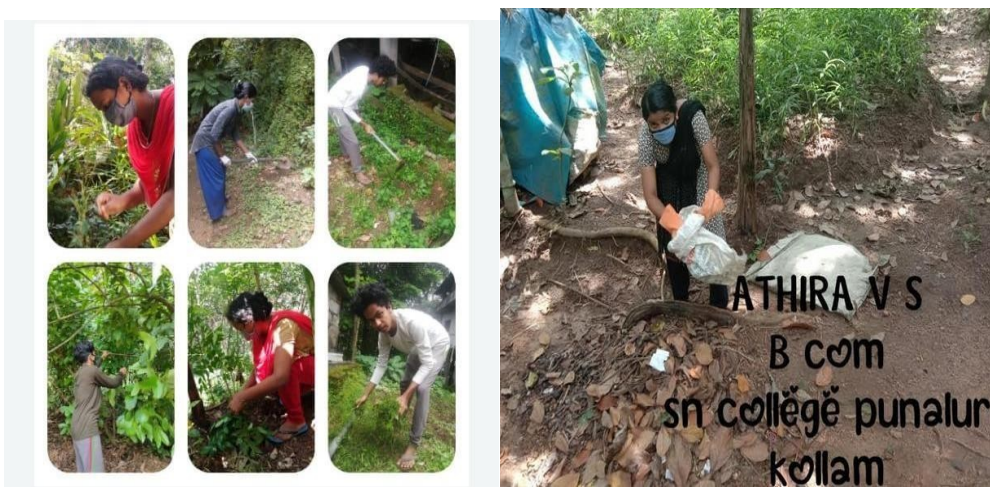
2. Elocution competition

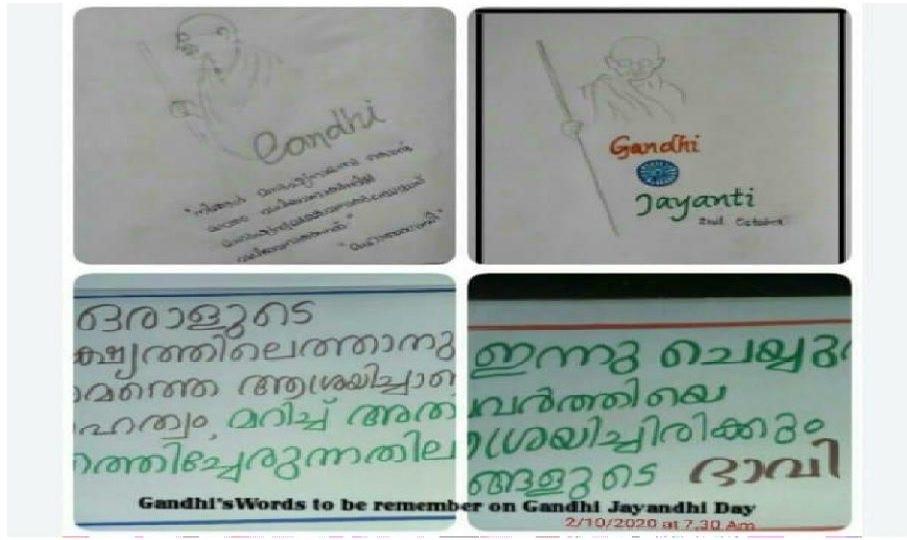


3. Swachh Bharat programme

Solar Eclipse of December 14, 2020

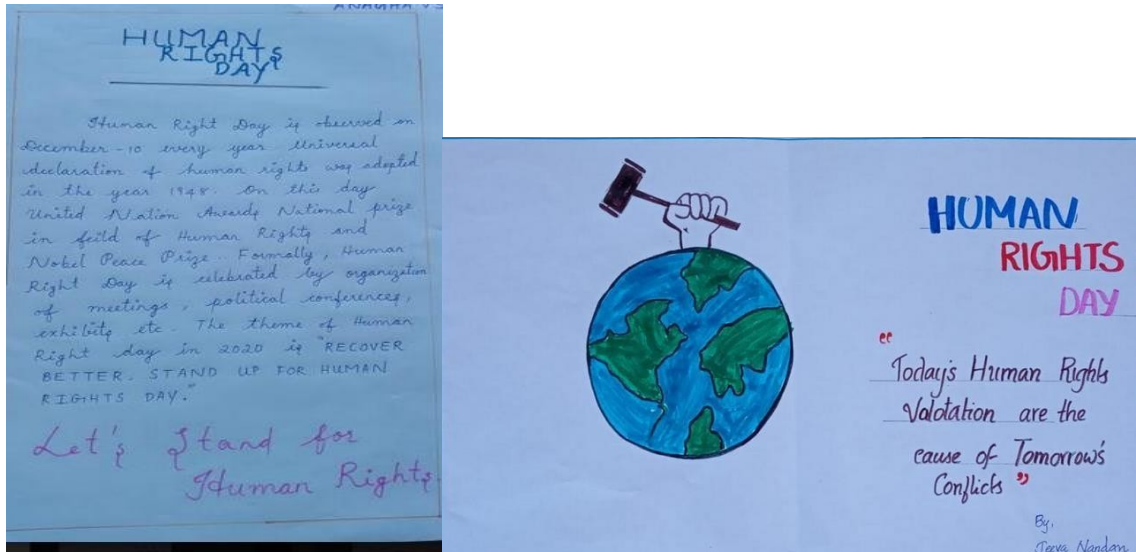

The Moon's apparent diameter will be larger because the eclipse will occur only 18 days after perigee.



10/12/2020- Observance of Human Rights Day

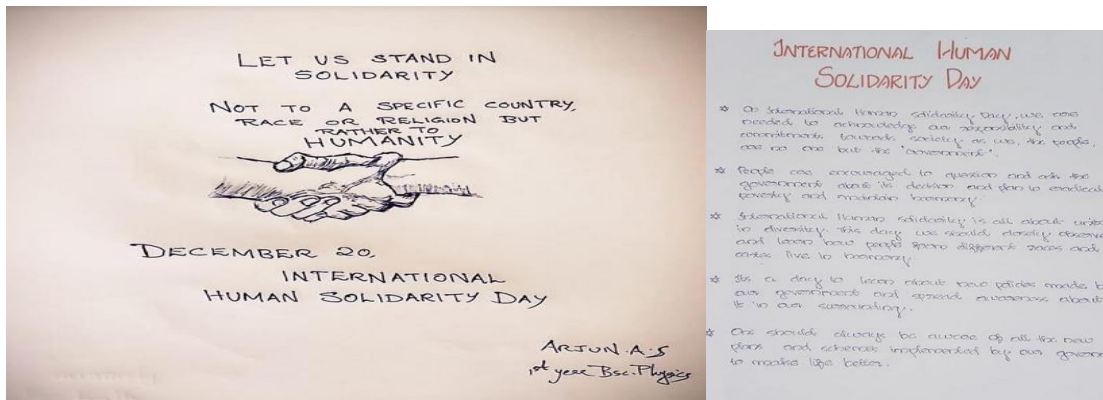

The basic objective of observation of National Science Day is to spread the message of importance of science and its application among the people.

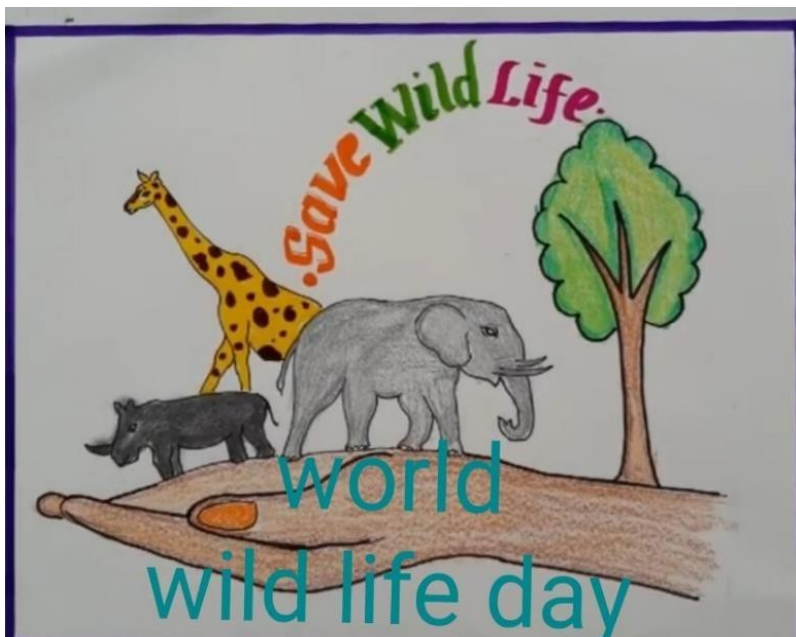

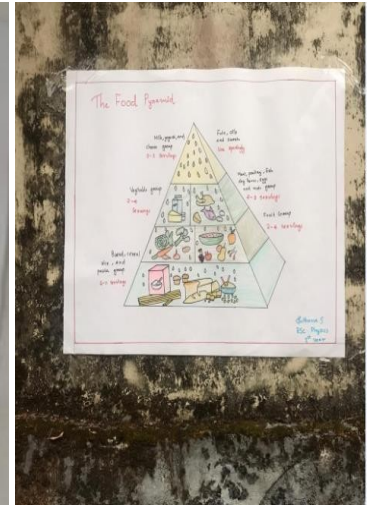
24/03/2021- Tuberculosis Day
