REPORT OF WALK WITH SCHOLAR PROGRAMME 2019-20

Sree Narayana College Punalur established in 1965 is a leading institution which provide enlightenment through education to thousands of pupil in the eastern hilly area of Kollam District. The college offers 8 degree courses and 3 PG programmes. Walk with a scholar programme of state government launched in 2014-15 has been successfully running for the last few years. Ms. Kavitha K.S., Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce is the present coordinator of the programme.

As per the directions of the New Initiatives Office, 15 internal mentors were selected for I, II and III year students. Six students each from five departments (Commerce, Mathematics, Physics, Communicative English and Chemistry) were selected for the programme. First year mentors selected are Dr. Ratheesh T , Department of Physics, Dr. Bijo S Anand , Department of Mathematics , Simi B S Department of Commerce , Dr. Divya Jayan, Department of Chemistry and Resmi Raveendran , Department of English. Each mentor has been allotted six students from their own department.

Some Second Year and Third year mentors are replaced due to the transfer of teachers. Second year mentors include Ganga M R, Dr. Divya R, Sree Murukan A , Dr Arun V and Shibu T . Third year mentors include Dr. Anooja Babu, Arsha S S, Neetu Pradeep, Biji M S and Dr. Divya Sadasivan. 30 meritorious students were selected as mentees for each year after collecting their respective biodata and conducting interactive sessions.

The coordinator of WWS participated in an orientation Programme for coordinators held at Loyola Collge, Sreekaryam on 11th June 2019. The coordinator also participated in a meeting held at Loyola College on 21 August 2019 that gave directions to the coordinators regarding the implementation of the programme. A monitoring committee was constituted to monitor the programme. The committee included the Principal, the Coordinator, IQAC convener, two senior teachers and two student representatives from WWS. The I year mentees were given an Orientation class for making them familiarize with the various initiatives of the programme.



An amount of Rs. 1,37,600 was credited to BIMS and an advance amount of 75 % (Rs 1,03,200) was withdrawn and credited to WWS joint bank account on December 2019. WWS programme for the year 2018-19 was inaugurated by the Principal Dr .T Pradeep. Several external mentoring sessions were conducted from September 2019 to January 2019 by experts in various fields. Study materials along with note books and pens were distributed to the students.

External and Internal mentoring sessions were conducted following the strict guidelines given by the New Initiatives Office



WWS is a programme intended to mould the skills and talents of students, and motivate them to come forth with good traits and competencies. As a part of the programme certain sessions were organized for the scholars for bringing forth their values and creating positive attitude among them.

One such session was for inculcating democratic and constitutional values among them. The session was handled by Jithin Sankar, Faculty, Department of History, NSS Hindu College

Changanassery. The session was arranged for the first year scholars on 25 January 2020 at 10am. The session was highly interactive and beneficial which made the scholars eager and enthusiastic to know about the basic constitutional values of the country, the role and contribution of democracy to the country. The class also made awareness among the mentees regarding the duties and responsibilities of an ideal citizen. The session came to an end at 1 pm.



Another session on Gender Sensitization was held on 7th December 2019 for the second year mentees. The session was handled by Smt. Aswathy Chandrabhanu , Assistant Professor, S. N. College for Women , Kollam . The session included group discussions, debate and the mentees actively participated in the sessions. The session has been concluded at 12:30 pm .



An awareness class on environmental sensitization was conducted by Dr. S Jisha , Faculty, Department of Zoology , S N College , **Punalur** on 7/12/2019 from 1:30 pm to 3 pm. With the help of an attractive power point presentation the resource person explained the importance of nature, the issues faced by it and the measures to be taken for conserving the nature.



For improving the soft skills of the scholars, a session was organized by Sreeraj R , Training and Placement Officer, Bishop Jerome Institute , Kollam, on 9/11/ 2019 for second year scholars . The session was a highly interactive one, which provided many brain storming activities to the scholars. Motivational session for Self-awareness-SWOT analysis, making person development plan PDP has also been given to the first year students on 24/12/2019.



Another productive session given during the year was “Developing Scientific temper –essential aspect of research in Contemporary Society”, handled by Dr. B Hari, for first year mentees. It was an effort for developing interest and accelerating their inner traits towards research .Session was very much interesting and gave a good insight among the students regarding the process of research along with their studies. Two additional sessions on “How to review an academic book?” and “How to Review a Journal Article?” were also given to the mentees. The sessions were on 7th September 2019, 28th September 2019 and October 2019.





An interactive session named “Art and self development –Theatre and other expressive art form as a medium of self expression” with theatre artist , Sri P J Unnikrishnan , Drama artist and state award winner was held on 27/12/2019. It was an opportunity for the mentees to interact with the renowned artist and understand the importance of art form in the daily life of humans.



The mentees were also given a chance to interact with a Psychologist Dr. Anand , Consultant Psychologist, Vijaya Hospital, Kottarakkara, on 28/12/2019 and a leading advocate of the locality.

REPORT OF MOTIVATIONAL VISIT , WWS 2019-20

As a part of Walk With a Scholar Programme 2019-20, a proposal for motivational visit has been given as per the directions from the Office of the New Initiatives and it was approved.

A motivational visit for WWS mentees to Ernakulam was held on 31st January, 2020. The institutions aimed to visit include CUSAT, Kochi, Kerala History Museum, Metro rail, Kochi and LULU international hypermarket Kochi.

Thirty mentees and two teachers (Coordinator and one Internal Mentor) were included in the team. Team started the journey on 31st January 2020 at 5 am.

The team reached CUSAT by 10 'o' clock. Prior consent was acquired from the Registrar of CUSAT and Dr Shaiju, Department of Physics was the coordinating faculty for our visit. He arranged a short awareness class and interaction session at the General Library of CUSAT. Students got an opportunity to familiarize with new knowledge resources, methods of accessing repositories, etc. through the interaction session with librarians. The mentees were given an opportunity to view the vast resources of books, e-journals etc. available in the CUSAT library.

In the afternoon there were interactive sessions arranged in physics and mathematics departments. Students were given information about some of the courses

and social extension activities of CUSAT. The mentees were also given a chance to visit the science museum.

A separate pavilion was arranged for showing the growth and success of ISRO. Statues of various scientists were arranged along with the details of their contribution. Faculties explained various laws and theories with the help of the equipment and the everyday use of these laws. It was a remarkable experience for the mentees especially from the science disciplines. The team also visited the botanical garden.

After completing the various sessions in CUSAT, the team visited the Kerala History Museum Kalamassery, metro rail and LULU hypermarket.
