*Candidates who enjoy Communal Reservation such as SEBC, SC/ST who have BPL endorsement in the Ration Card are **NOT** eligible for BPL reservation. Only candidates belonging to **FORWARD COMMUNITIES** who are Economically Backward are eligible for BPL reservation. Such candidates must produce BPL Certificate from the Village Officer/Revenue Authority /Local Body concerned along with community certificate from the competent authority. In case of failure to specify the community, the candidate shall not be eligible for reservation in the BPL category.

Note: (a) Thiyya and Billava will be considered as Ezhava Community for reservation.
(b) SEBC candidates should produce Non Creamy layer Certificate for getting the benefit of reservation.
(c) The enhancement of additional seats in Government colleges and University departments shall not incur any additional financial commitment to the Government/University.

The remaining 50% of the seats shall be filled by the management, by candidates of their choice, observing the prescribed eligibility conditions. The candidates who apply under management quota shall also register online before closure of admission.

The management quota applications can be used only for admission to management quota seats.

Note: The fee structure of the Self-financing Colleges is higher than that of Govt/Aided Colleges. Government fee concession is not available to candidates enjoying communal reservation, if admitted in Self-financing Colleges.

Claims that are not mentioned at the time of online submission of application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced later on. The claims for mandatory reservation once made cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstances.

5.1.1 Claim for Communal reservation under 'Socially and Educationally Backward Classes' (SEBC):

Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, as amended from time to time.

- Candidates belonging to Ezhava, Muslim, Other Backward Hindus, Latin Catholic/SIUC and Other Backward Christian communities, claiming reservation under SEBC quota should invariably produce 'Non Creamy layer Certificate' obtained from the Village Officer concerned. Candidate belonging to

RESERVATION OF SEATS

Types of Reservation: Seats will be reserved for the following categories in Govt./ Aided/ Self financing Colleges and UIT's for various First Degree Programmes.

A candidate can claim only one benefit at a time as per his/her choice for a particular purpose.

4.1 Reservation for Nominees

(i) Reservation for Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep.

An additional seat shall be created for each First Degree Programme (wherever necessary) in any Govt./Aided college, exclusively for the purpose of accommodating students sponsored by the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. This seat shall not be filled up by other candidates. The Head of the Institutions should forward the list of such candidates admitted, separately, to the University immediately after the admissions. (Govt. letter No.5455/B3/2006/H.Edn. dated 15-3-2006) (U.O.No.Ac.B1/1134/2006 dated 26-4-2006). The students should register online before obtaining admission.

(ii) Concession for Wards of Kashmiri Migrants.

The following relevant concessions are applicable for wards of Kashmiri Migrants for admission to the UG courses in all Affiliated Arts & Science Colleges – U.O.No.Ac.B1/910/Adms/2012, dated 09/04/2012.

- * Extension in date of admission by about 30 days.
- * Relaxation in cut off percentage up to 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- * Increase in intake capacity upto 5% course wise.
- * Waiving of domicile requirements.
- * Facilitation of migration in second and subsequent years.

(iii) Reservation for candidates from Jammu and Kashmir.

Two seats shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength to accommodate candidates belonging to Jammu & Kashmir for admission to UG programmes (wherever necessary) in all the affiliated colleges. (UO No. Ac B1/2292/Adms/2012 dated 01.03.2013). Such students should also register online.

(iv) Reservation for Inmates of Government Children's Home.

One seat shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength in each Govt./ Aided Colleges for Inmates of Government Children's Home and Establishments which functions as per Juvenile Justice Act. In the event of non applicants from the above establishments, the applications of candidates from approved Children's Homes duly recommended by the District Social Welfare Officer shall be considered. (U.O.No. Ac B1/055682/2012 dated 30.04.2013)

(v) Reservation of seats for the widows /wards of Defence Personnel, killed/disabled in action or during peace time.

Additional seats over and above the sanctioned strength may be created as and when required for the widows /wards of Defence Personnel, killed or disabled in action or during peace time, in Central /State Universities /Autonomous/ Professional / Non-Professional Institutions under the purview of Ministry of Human Resource Development as per UGC policy. (Applicable to Army/Navy/Airforce only. Not applicable to paramilitary forces/CAPF/GREF/Coast Guard etc.)

(vi) Reservation for Tamil Linguistic Minority (TLM).

5% seats of the sanctioned strength shall be created, over and above, for candidates belonging to Tamil Linguistic Minority in the following colleges as per GO (Ms) No. 148/96/H.Edn. dtd 01.08.1996. The candidates have to produce a certificate to this effect either from the Village officer/Tahsildar or from the MP/MLA of the area where he/she permanently resides.

- University College, Thiruvananthapuram
- Govt. Arts College, Thiruvananthapuram
- K.N.M Govt. Arts & Science College, Kanjiramkulam
- Govt. College, Kariavattom
- Govt. College for Women, Thiruvananthapuram

Such candidates should opt Tamil as Second Language, if offered by the college.

4.2 Reservation for Differently Abled Persons.

(i) 5% seats of the sanctioned strength shall be created over and above in Government/ Aided Colleges and UIT's, exclusively for candidates with benchmark disability (as per clause 32(I) of chapter VI, The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016).

(ii) In all other affiliated Colleges, additional seats will be created over and above sanctioned strength for candidates with benchmark disability as and when required.

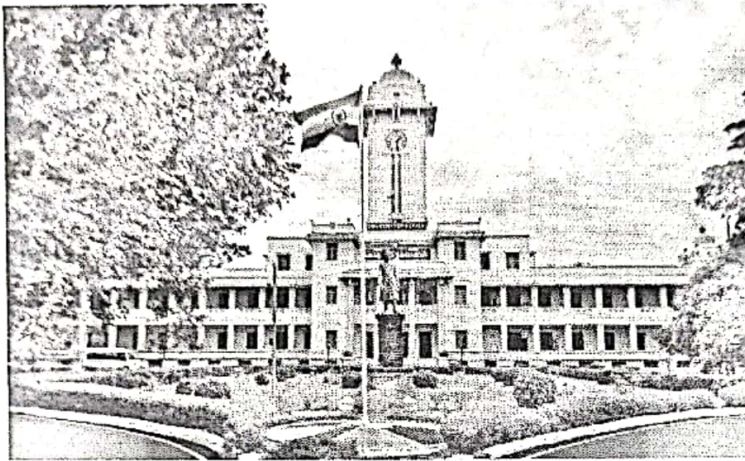

Mode of admission under Community Quota in Aided Colleges

- The seats under community quota in Aided Colleges will be filled by the Colleges concerned on the basis of merit and on the basis of community certificate issued by the Revenue Authorities/Parish Priest/any other Competent Authority.
- Registration to Community Quota will be effected in online mode only. Candidates need not submit the application for community quota admission in colleges. **Registration exclusively for community quota will not be permitted.** They can use the application number of their original registration and submit online application for Community Quota separately.
- The candidates who are eligible to apply for community quota in Aided colleges shall submit separate options for community quota after completing the online registration process. They shall use the "Community Quota" link provided in their profile for submitting the options. It may be noted that only those colleges, based on the community of the candidates, will be displayed for submitting options.
- The candidates can give a maximum of 20 options. There is no preference in options. **The options given by the candidates during online registration for merit seats will not be considered for community quota admission under any circumstances.**
- Candidates can add or delete options till the closure of online registration.
- From the applications submitted, the University will prepare ranklist of the eligible candidates on merit basis and the same will be published in the website.
- The candidates in the ranklist will be notified through press release, to appear at the opted colleges for certificate verification and admission thereafter, if eligible.
- All admissions to Community Quota (including the vacant seats of SC/ST converted in case of Aided Backward colleges with Minority status) are to be effected from the Community Quota ranklist of the colleges approved by the University.

List of communities that are considered for Community Quota Admission in various Aided Colleges are given in Annexure VI

No applications for community quota will be entertained after the last date of registration.

Applicants claiming reservation under Community quota in Aided Colleges, who belong to the community of the Management which runs the college, will have to produce community certificate from the Revenue authority/Parish Priest/any other competent authority concerned, at the time of admission.

Candidates belonging to Ezhava, Muslim, Other Backward Hindu, Latin Catholic/SIUC and Other Backward Christian communities, claiming reservation under SEBC quota should invariably produce 'Non Creamy Layer Certificate' obtained from the Village Officer concerned. Candidate belonging to Non Creamy Layer category only are eligible for claiming reservation to SEBC category. Annual Income is not a criteria for reservation for SEBC candidates. List of communities under SEBC category are given in Annexure V. *The validity of Non Creamy Layer certificate is one year.*

5.2 Claim for reservation under Scheduled Castes (SC) / Scheduled Tribes (ST) quota.

Candidates belonging to SC/ST communities allotted against merit seats or against the seats reserved for them are exempted from payment of fee at the time of admission. Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes quota should obtain the Caste/Community Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahsildar. (See Annexure II and Annexure III for list of SC and ST). *The validity of SC/ST certificate is three years.*

Warning: Those who produce false SC/ST Certificate for claiming reservation under SC/ST quota shall be liable for penalties as per rules.

The seats unavailed by the SC candidates will go to ST candidates and vice versa.

5.3 Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates.

Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates are eligible for the un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota. The communities given in Annexure IV only are eligible for such un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota (G.O.(Ms)No.14/2017/BCDD dated 02.08.2017). OEC candidates who possess 'Non Creamy Layer Certificate' obtained from the Village Officer concerned alone are eligible for such seats.

Note : Converted Christians do not come under the SC/ST category. They belong to OEC category. (Ref. Annexure IV)

5.4 Claim for fee concession to OEC candidates.

Candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities are exempted from payment of fee at the time of admission under Government/Community quota irrespective of annual family income as per G.O (MS) No. 36/07/SCSTDD, dated: 03.07.2007. (Communities listed in Annexure IV)

OEC candidates will be granted the fee concession based on the Non-Creamy Layer Certificate. But those OEC candidates who do not come under Non-Creamy Layer Category should produce the Community Certificate obtained from the village officer at the time of admission for availing the fee concession.

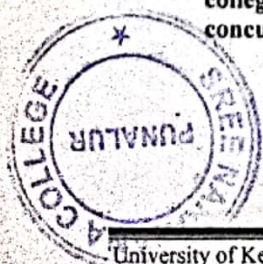
5.5 Claim for fee concession to the candidates who get OEC educational assistance.

As per the G.O.(Ms) 10/2014/BCDD dated 23.05.2014, 30 communities from state OBC list are selected for OEC educational assistance subjected to a maximum of Rs. 8 Lakh annual income. (G.O (MS) No. 03/2018/BCDD) dated 09.04.2018 (Communities listed in Annexure V.A) They should provide Community and Income Certificates from the Village Officer at the time of admission. *The validity of income certificate for OEC is one year.*

5.6 Claim for reservation under Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category in Govt./Self Financing Colleges and UIT's

Candidates belonging to the Communities listed in Annexure V.B who are economically backward are eligible for EWS reservation. Such candidates must produce either of the certificates from the village officer namely "The applicant belonging to Anthyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Priority House Hold (PHH) category" or "The income and assets certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in General Category" (Communities listed in Annexure V.B). (Format of certificates is given in Annexure XI and XII). Ration Card or BPL certificate is NOT a valid document to avail EWS reservation. Candidates who enjoy any other Communal Reservation such as SEBC, SC/ST are NOT eligible for EWS reservation.

5.7 Not with standing anything contained in the Statutes, the selection of students in Government colleges shall be governed by the rules prescribed by the Government from time to time with the concurrence of the University in respect of such admissions.
