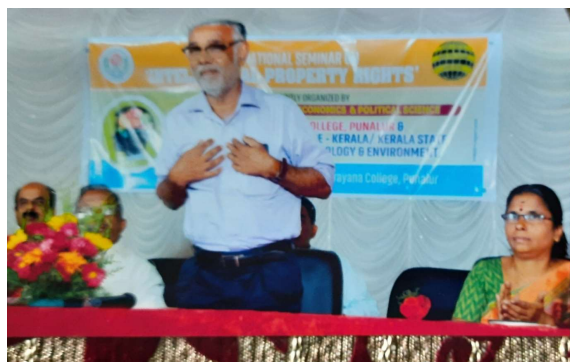


### **Intellectual Property Rights**

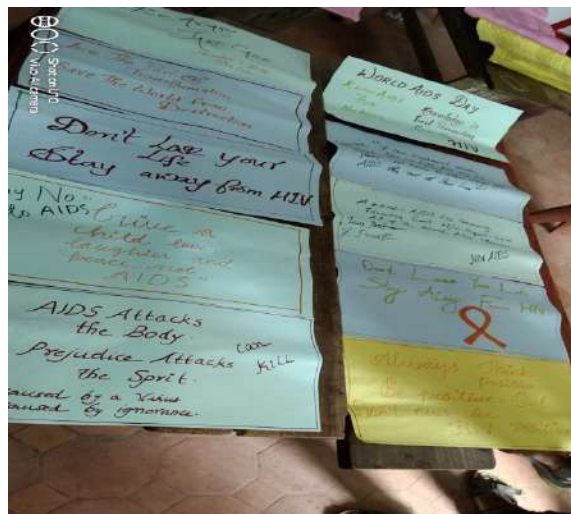
### **CONSTITUTION DAY CELEBRATION (26 /11/2019)**

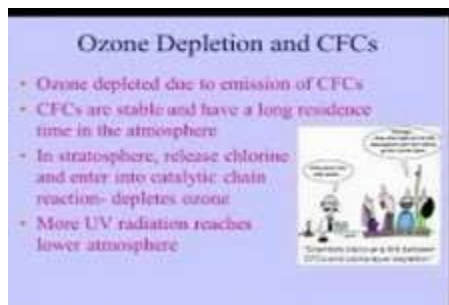
(21/06/2020):- Yoga Day Celebration

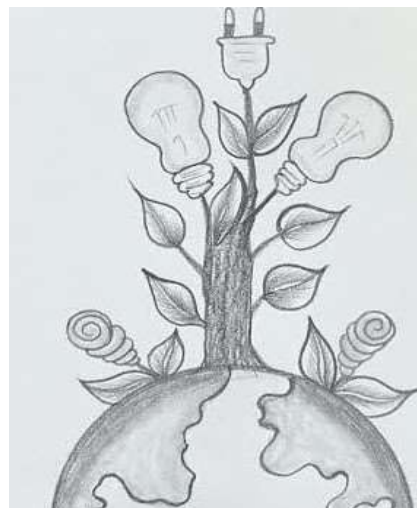
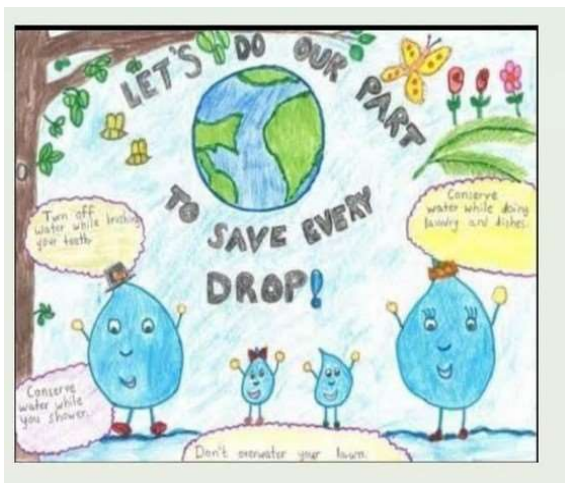
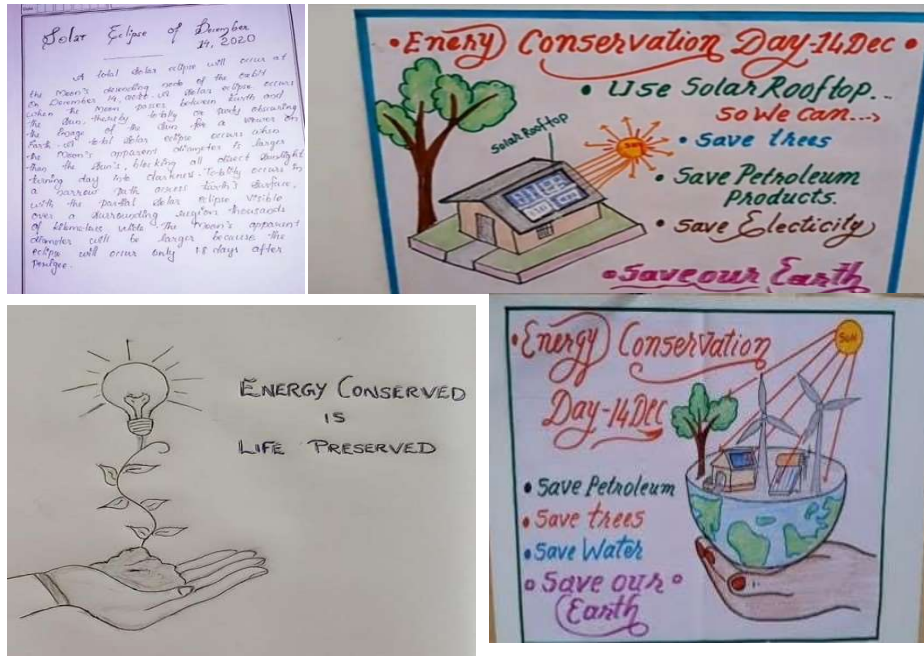
## 01/12/2020- Observance of World Aids Day

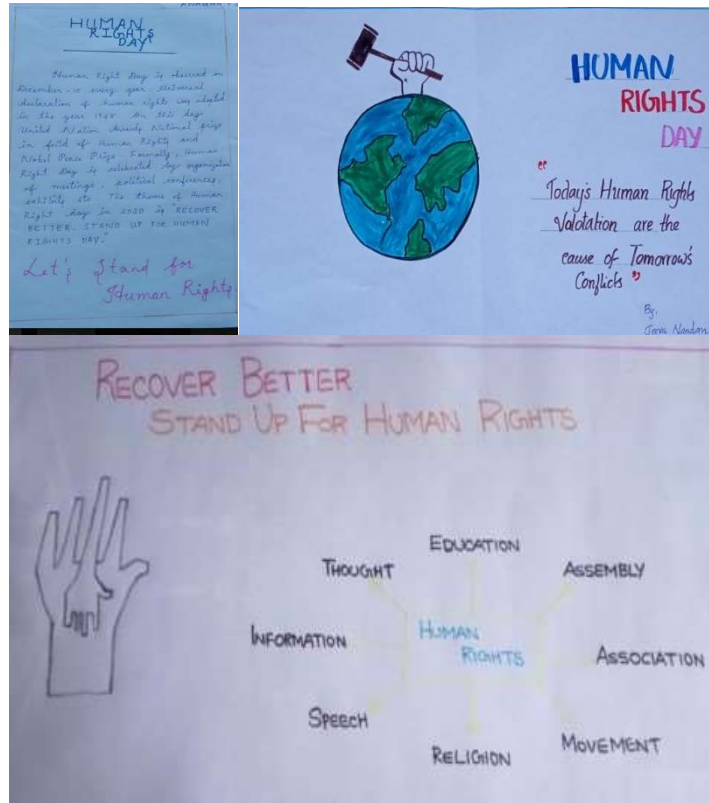


## 14/12/2020- Energy Conservation Day

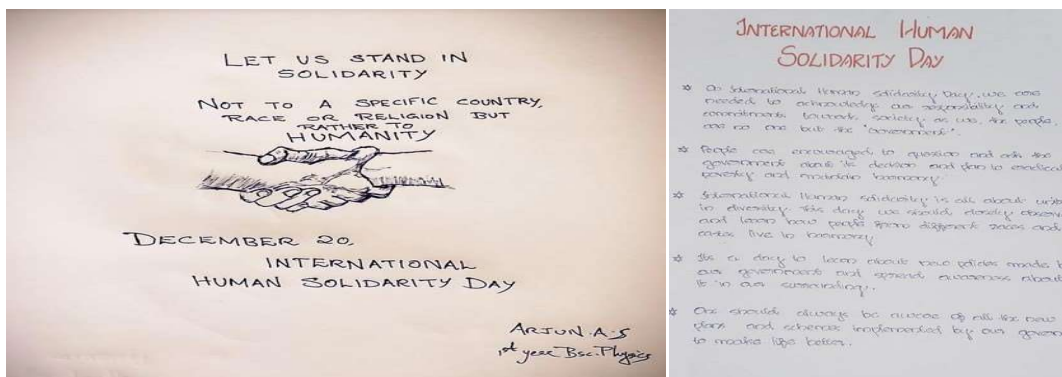

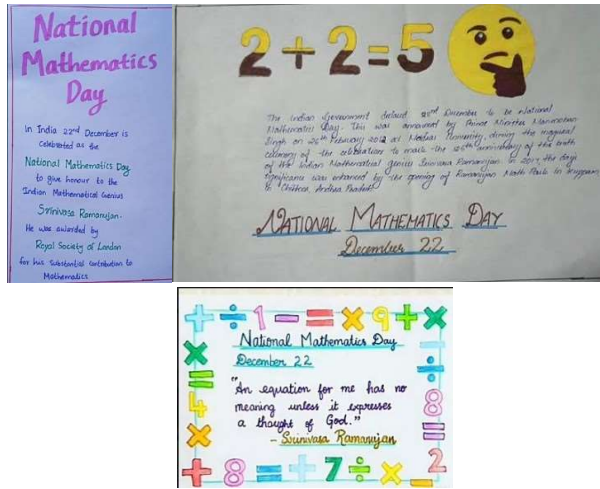


20/12/2020- International Human Solidarity Day

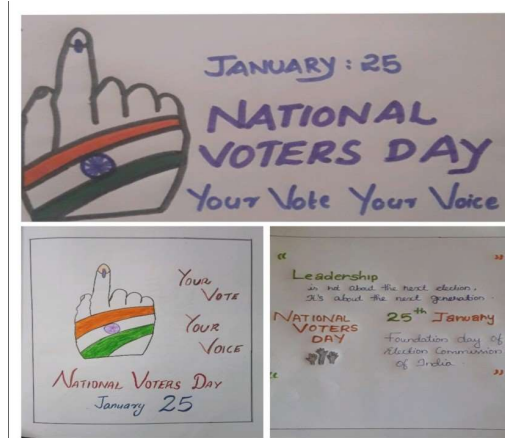


**15/01/2021- Army Day**

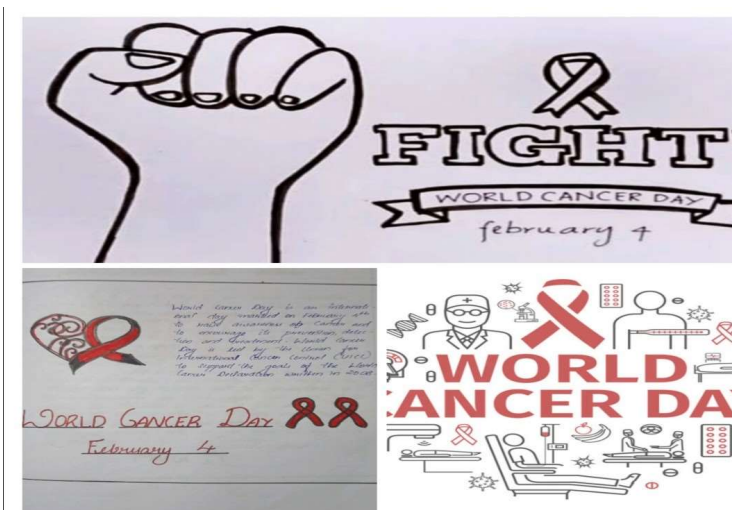
## 26/01/2021- Observance of Republic Day

## 20/02/2021- World Social Work Day

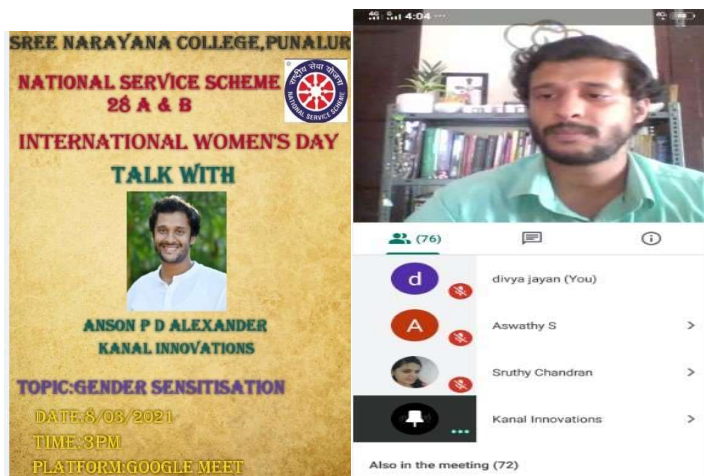
On World Day of Social Justice, our students created posters and essays with the theme 'A

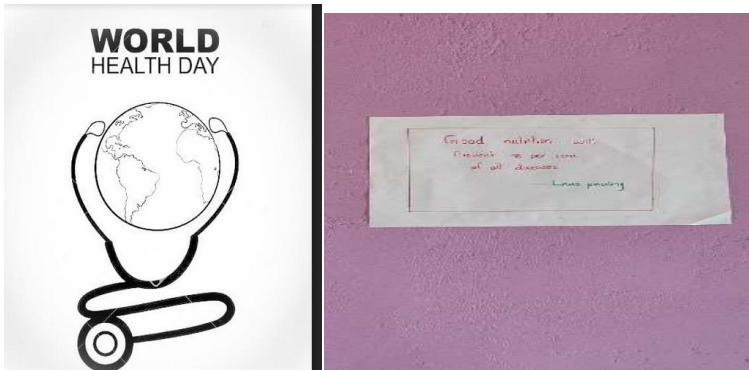
